Description

The SFMTA is embarking on a major effort to replace its existing technically-obsolete Metro Subway fare collection system with a new state-of-the-art fare collection system. The project is composed of the following elements: 1) procuring and installing approximately 100 bi-modal faregates; 2) procuring and installing new ticket vending machines; 3) installing new control panels and displays for booth agents; and 4) implementing a central control data collection system.

The Fare Equipment Replacement Project is consistent with the following SFMTA Strategic Plan goals:

Goal 3 – External Affairs – Community Relations

To improve the customer experience, community value and enhance the image of SFMTA, as well as ensure SFMTA is a leader in the industry.
