Description

Irving St is a vibrant corridor with a mix of uses and several nearby transit lines. The planned sidewalk bulb-outs will encourage people to use alternative forms of transportation by improving pedestrian safety and comfort while also improving the connections between new cultural attractions in Golden Gate Park, the commercial corridor, the University of California Medical School, schools, a dense residential area, and several transit lines.

The Inner Sunset Traffic Calming project is consistent with the following SFMTA Strategic Plan goals:

To provide safe, accessible, clean, environmentally sustainable service and encourage the use of auto-alternative modes through the Transit First Policy.
