1. Minutes: Approved October 25 Minutes with correction

2. Public Comment: Kathy Roberts: City should sever the lease with MCCP on garage because MCCP has not met financing requirements. Bob Planthold: Pi read his statement that the Concourse Authority has not considered pedestrian needs. Bruce Livingston, San: Spoke on proposed Pedestrian Protection Ordinance by Supervisor Ma, subject of a hearing at the Land Use Committee on December 13. PSAC will discuss at December meeting.

3. Walk to School: Eileen Ross: Eight Schools worked with DPT for successful Walk to School Day with kids walking together with signs and then enjoying snacks. Chinatown ran their own event at one school. Participation has increased over the last few years.

4. Golden Gate Park Pedestrian Improvement Plan: Frank: Delivered Park maps and preliminary list of possible projects. DPT and RPD will develop more detail soon.

5. Proposition K Report and PMP: Frank distributed information. PSAC should give their input to priorities for the first five years of Prop K Transportation Authority expenditures. PSAC will generally follow a PMP process of: Discuss DPT draft scope at December PSAC meeting; Hold Working Committee meeting on PMP Scope; Approve at January PSAC meeting.

6. Accessible Audible Pedestrian Signal Report: Frank: Distributed more detailed lists of proposed sites. PSAC took no action.

7. Visitacion Valley Pedestrian Master Plan: Bruce Livingston: Discussed a list of pedestrian improvements that SAN along with neighbor groups is proposing to Muni and DPT. PSAC voted: PSAC supports in concept the efforts of neighbors and pedestrian advocates to convert Visitacion Valley to a transit oriented development walkable livable community.
