Central Subway Utility Relocation Construction Begins Installation of Eyebolts for the Overhead Contact System on August 15 SFMTA Contract Number 1251

Project Description

On Monday, August 15, Synergy Project Management, the contractor, will begin installation of eyebolts for the overhead contact system required for the temporary trolley coach reroute in the downtown area for the Central Subway Project.
