Project Description

The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) and Synergy Project Management (Contractor) will begin utility relocation for the Union Square/Market Street area. This will require relocating all underground utilities from the street to underneath the sidewalks along Stockton Street. Utility Relocation work on Stockton Street will be performed from January 2011 to approximately July 2012.

Here are some facts that you should be aware of:

- Work area will be along Stockton Street from Sutter to Market Streets, including side streets on Sutter, Geary, Post, O'Farrell, Ellis, Market streets and Maiden Lane.
- At all times only one lane of traffic will be available on Stockton Street between Sutter and Market streets.
- The open lane of traffic on Stockton Street will be available for Muni buses, taxis, tour buses and delivery trucks only.
- The contractor will always maintain safe pedestrian access to all stores during business hours.
- Those traveling or working in the area can expect an increase in noise, dust and traffic as a result of the construction.
