Written 150-Word Public Testimony by Edward Mason for Minutes of SFMTA Citizens' Advisory Council Regular Meeting June 4, 2026: Agenda Item #6, Public Comment:

The 511 Telephone Departure Time feature has experienced misinformation. Listen for the "as of time" to ensure the prediction is current.

On the expanding technology topic, Uber and Chinese WeRide will initiate a pilot project in Madrid, Spain. Safety Drivers will be aboard the Supervan model GXR.

Uber and WeRide already jointly operate this vehicle in the United Arab Emirates since November 2025. Technology is moving forward and we must monitor the impact on transit.

Edward inquired if there is any connection with the flock camera program and the red light and speed cameras.

Anthony Moor stated that he is a resident of District 8 and a transit rider of all types. He stated that In the presentation data, about 18% of speeders are getting three or more citations. In data that was compiled in New York City, they discovered that an even smaller subset of about 1.5% are super speeders, which means they're getting six or more citations in a year. According to the League of American Cyclists that 1.5 % who are super speeders were involved in over 20% of pedestrian deaths in New York City. He encouraged the SFMTA to research whether San Francisco has this sort of subset of super speeders. He said knowing this information is extremely important to reducing deaths and injuries of vulnerable users and implementing the, or sorry and to reaching the goal of Vision Zero.
