FOR PUBLIC HEARING

The Sustainable Streets Division of the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency will hold a public hearing on Friday, May 4, 2018, at 10:00 AM, in Room 416 (Hearing Room 4), City Hall, 1 Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, San Francisco, CA 94102, to consider the following proposals:

#### 1. <u>RESCIND – MUNI STOP</u>

North Point Street, south side, east of Van Ness Avenue, Muni Route 47 (removes service stop for the 47 Van Ness; bus zone to remain and to serve other lines) (Supervisor District 2)

#### 2. ESTABLISH - TOW-AWAY, NO PARKING ANY TIME

Monterey Boulevard, south side, from Baden Street to 30 feet westerly (extends current red zone by 15 feet) (Supervisor District 7)

#### 3. ESTABLISH - TOW-AWAY, NO PARKING ANY TIME

Naples Street, east side, from Rolph Street to 25 feet southerly (Supervisor District 11)

#### 4. ESTABLISH – VARIABLE MESSAGE SIGN

16<sup>th</sup> Street, eastbound, approximately 125 feet east of Missouri Street (Includes an electrical cabinet) (Supervisor District 10) \*

#### 5. ESTABLISH - BUS ZONE

Potrero Avenue, west side, from mid-block crosswalk between 22<sup>nd</sup> Street and 23<sup>rd</sup> Street to 123 feet southerly (extends existing bus zone from 70 feet to 123 feet and removes two parking spaces) (Supervisor District 9)

#### 6. ESTABLISH - RED ZONE

Schwerin Street, west side, from Sunnydale Avenue to 28 feet southerly (extends existing 10-foot red zone and removes one parking space)

Schwerin Street, east side, from Sunnydale Avenue to 10 feet southerly (red zone removes 10 feet out of a 30-foot space for parking – does not remove a full parking space) \* (Supervisor District 11)

#### 7. ESTABLISH - PERPENDICULAR PARKING

Texas Street, east side, from 20<sup>th</sup> Street to 703 feet southerly (extends existing perpendicular parking by 44 feet) (Supervisor District 10)

#### 8. ESTABLISH - STOP SIGN

Vandewater Street, westbound, at Mason Street, stopping the stem of this T-intersection (Supervisor District 3)

2728 - 2738 Mission Street (Creates parking eligibility for this building; no signage changes) (Supervisor District 9)

#### 11. ESTABLISH - RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING ELIGIBILITY, AREA J

1667 Haight Street (Creates permit parking eligibility for this building; no signage changes) (Supervisor District 5)

#### 12. <u>ESTABLISH – RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING ELIGIBILITY, AREA Z</u>

1260-1262 Valencia Street (Creates permit parking eligibility for this building; no signage changes) (Supervisor Districts 8 and 9)

#### 13. ESTABLISH - NO STOPPING ANYTIME, EXCEPT MARKED POLICE VEHICLES

- A. 16th Street, south side, from De Haro Street to 150 feet easterly
- B. De Haro Street, east side, between 16th Street and 17th Street
- C. 17<sup>th</sup> Street, north side, between De Haro Street and Carolina Street (Supervisor District 10)

#### 14(a). <u>RESCIND – NO PARKING ANYTIME EXCEPT BICYCLES</u>

3<sup>rd</sup> Street, west side, from 56 feet to 76 feet north of Newcomb Avenue (20-foot zone formerly car parking meter space #4616) (Supervisor District 10) \*

#### 14(b). <u>RESCIND – YELLOW METERED LOADING ZONE, 8 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY</u> <u>THROUGH SATURDAY</u>

3<sup>rd</sup> Street, west side, from 76 feet to 116 feet north of Newcomb Avenue (40-foot zone, parking meter space #4612 and #4614) (Supervisor District 10) \*

#### 14(c). ESTABLISH – GENERAL METERED PARKING, 9 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY

3<sup>rd</sup> Street, west side from 56 feet to 116 feet north of Newcomb Avenue (one new parking meter, two yellow zone meters converted to general metered parking) (Supervisor District 10) \*

Categorically exempt from Environmental Review: CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 Class 1(c): Operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities.

- J. Anza Street, north side, from 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 20 feet easterly (removes one general unmetered parking space)
- K. 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue, west side, from Geary Boulevard to 23 feet northerly (removes one general metered parking space)
- L. Cabrillo Street, north side, from 9th Avenue to 7 feet westerly
- M. Cabrillo Street, south side, from 9th Avenue to 8 feet easterly
- N. Cabrillo Street, south side, from 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 20 feet westerly (removes one general unmetered parking space)

Ingalls Street, west side, from Palou Avenue to 51 feet southerly (42'-7" bike share station with red zones on either end of the station) (Supervisor District 10) \*

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Appeal Rights under Chapter 31 of the San Francisco Administrative Code: For Approval Actions, the Planning Department has issued a CEQA exemption determination or negative declaration, which may be viewed online at http://www.sf-planning.org/index.aspx?page=3447. Following approval of the item by the SFMTA City Traffic Engineer, the CEQA determination is subject to appeal within the time frame specified in S.F. Administrative Code Section 31.16, typically within 30 calendar days of the Approval Action. For information on filing a CEQA appeal, contact the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors at City Hall, 1 Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, Room 244, San Francisco, CA 94102, or call (415) 554-5184. Under CEQA, in a later court challenge, a litigant may be limited to raising only those issues previously raised at a hearing on the project or in written correspondence delivered to the Board of Supervisors or other City board, commission or department at, or prior to, such hearing, or as part of the appeal hearing process on the CEQA decision.
