    - i. Bob Lockhart mentioned that a there had been a walk from Sutter to Union at some point and suggested another walking tour of the project.
      - 1. Project staff stated they would look into possibly hosting another one of these in the fall.
    - ii. Bob Anderson brought up that the big belly garbage can was freed up and he appreciated that those concerns were addressed.
    - iii. Bob Lockhart said that when originally paved, the driveways were too steep so that the bottoms of cars were scratching. However, this was addressed very quickly.

- iv. Randy Uang asked about the kind of support the Van Ness project provides to businesses besides the car card campaign, especially in regards to funds.
  - SFMTA works with the Office of Economic and Workforce Development (OEWD) and they are providing a suite of services to businesses on Van Ness. Additionally, the MTA Board has allocated some MTA funding to create a business support fund to support businesses, to possibly include a low interest loan. But the Board has yet to direct the project on how to use those funds.
