#### **RECENT PROGRESS**

- CAO completed draft indemnification agreement, PG&E added language which prompted discussion.
- On 6/18/19, the SFMTA Board of Directors approved the indemnification agreement with PG&E.
- PG&E requested video inspection of the conduits as part of the supporting document for the indemnification.
- SFMTA to perform video inspection.

### **UCSF Platform Extension and Crossover Track**



#### **RECENT PROGRESS**

- Coordinated final shutdown for this project.
- Installed train, track and traffic signal wiring, signage on platform and canopy glass, and new train signal cabinets.

#### **KEY MILESTONES**

- Construct new platform to service both the inbound and outbound trains and greatly expand transit capacity in preparation for large crowds.
- The two pre-existing platforms, which were split as separate inbound and outbound were demolished as part of the project.

\*SFMTA finance is working to abate any project overruns with available funding.

- Contractor completed the Van Ness and North point restroom site.
- Contractor started punch list items for Rivera and Lower Great Highway, and the 20th and Buckingham sites.
- Project team will proceed to complete the task order closeout.

#### **KEY MILESTONES**

About 56-percent of the sewer work and about 54-percent of the water line were installed in Phase 1A and 1B. About 39-percent of the sidewalk work has been completed in Phases 1A and 1B.

#### **RECENT PROGRESS**

Work on Phase 1C of the project has been started and continues. Sewer and water work are underway, and the full project completion date is scheduled for summer 2021.

#### **RECENT PROGRESS**

- There are 56 cars now revenue service ready and in operations. An additional 7 cars are on site in the process of testing, commissioning and burn in.
- Three more cars will be delivered in the next quarter to complete the first phase delivery.
- Completion date of the procurement of the 68 expansion cars is scheduled for July 2021.

#### **KEY MILESTONES**

The goals of this project was to improve safety; provide a more attractive pedestrian environment; improve Muni travel time and reinforce the neighborhood identity of the Laurel Village Shopping Center.

### **RECENT PROGRESS**

Signal and bulb-out work substantially completed, working with PW to close out once all change orders have been completed.

• Project is 30% complete with anticipated substantial completion on May 2020.

- Local agencies are coordinating these street safety improvements with underground water and wastewater infrastructure upgrades.
- Once the project is complete, Caltrans will repave Lombard Street.
