WHEREAS, The agreement stipulated that one director to the TJPA Board of Directors is to be appointed by the SFMTA Board of Directors; and,

WHEREAS, This same agreement allowed each appointing authority to appoint an alternate director to fulfill the duties of the director appointed if the director is absent or unavailable; and,

WHEREAS, The SFMTA Board of Directors wishes to appoint Gwyneth Borden to serve as an alternate director on the TJPA Board of Directors; and,

WHEREAS, The appointment of individuals to policy bodies does not constitute a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations Section 15060(c); now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors does hereby appoint Gwyneth Borden as an alternate director to serve on the Transbay Joint Powers Authority Board of Directors, effective October 6, 2021.
