Project Summary



Project location: Brotherhood Way at Alemany Blvd and Sagamore St/Orizaba Ave

The Brotherhood/Alemany Safety Improvements Project ("Brotherhood/Alemany") seeks to improve the safety, efficiency and urban design of this important multi-leg intersection, which also includes the Sagamore Street and Orizaba Avenue approaches. The SFMTA-led project is separate from the San Francisco Transportation Authority (SFCTA)'s Brotherhood Way Safety and Circulation Plan, although the two agencies will coordinate on outreach and funding, and to ensure near-term investments are compatible with longer-term plan concepts. This project may also inform and support the siting of a new potential public library branch at the Orizaba Ave corner, pending further planning and analysis.

Design Objectives (Draft)

- Provide fully-signalized pedestrian crossings of Alemany Blvd and Brotherhood Way, and possibly also of Sagamore St and Orizaba Ave pending further analysis*
- Support safety, open space access, and good urban design by reclaiming and repurposing excess public right-of-way
- Generally maintain existing traffic patterns and capacity while reducing egregious speeding and improving overall traffic compliance



*Prior to the project adding a traffic signal for the westbound Brotherhood Way crosswalk, the SFMTA is planning to install a rectangular rapid flashing beacon ('RRFB') at this location in 2024.
