

#### Sustainable Streets Division Directive Order No. 6697

The proposed modification would add RPP eligibility to the residents of 150 Franklin Street so they can purchase parking permits for their vehicle to park within RPP Area HV

Proposal will align the school bus loading zone time restriction with the school's start/end times.

**Decision:** On hold pending exploration of a Moscone Park site as requested by the Supervisor.

Proposal to install a Bay Wheels bike share station in the parking lane on the west side of Polk Street, south of Bush Street, adjacent to Modern Thai and McTeague's Saloon.

# **GENERAL COMMENTS:**

One comment requesting the status of flashing beacons at 38<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Geary Boulevard. One comment requesting for increased crossing time and automatic pedestrian signals on Fulton Street west of 25<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

Whether or not the City Traffic Engineer's decision is considered a Final SFMTA Decision is determined by Division II, Section 203 of the Transportation Code. If the City Traffic Engineer approves a parking or traffic



modification, it is considered a Final SFMTA Decision. If the City Traffic Engineer disapproves or declines a parking or traffic modification, a member of the public must request additional review by the SFMTA of that decision which shall be conducted pursuant to Division II, Section 203 of the Transportation Code before the decision becomes a Final SFMTA Decision. Final SFMTA Decisions, whether made by the City Traffic Engineer or the SFMTA Board, can be reviewed by the Board of Supervisors pursuant to <u>Ordinance 127-18</u>. Decisions reviewable by the Board of Supervisors are denoted with a pound (**#**).
