## **MUNI FORWARD SERVICE IMPROVEMENTS**

- Launching new 55 16<sup>th</sup> Street line
- Expanded 44 O'Shaughnessy frequency
  - AM Peak improvement from 10 min to 7-8 min
  - PM Peak improvement from to 9-10 min to 8 min
- Schedule reliability improvements on the 9/9L, 14, 24, 33, 49, and 52 lines
- Improved operator restroom
  - access
  - 35 Eureka
  - 38 Geary shortline
  - 44 O'Shaughnessy
  - 54 Felton
  - 56 Rutland

## **55 16<sup>TH</sup> STREET LINE STOPS**

- Serves all 22 Fillmore stops on 16<sup>th</sup> Street between Mission Street & Vermont Street
- New inbound & outbound bus stops and zones proposed for:
  - 16<sup>th</sup> Street at Rhode Island
  - 16<sup>th</sup> Street at Wisconsin
  - 16<sup>th</sup> Street at Missouri
  - 16<sup>th</sup> Street at 4<sup>th</sup> Street (UCSF Benioff Children's Hospital)
- New stops match proposed 16<sup>th</sup> Street bus rapid transit recommendations



## **OUTREACH SUMMARY**

- February-March 2014: Five meetings
- Door-to-door outreach on 16<sup>th</sup> Street in early November 2014
- Mailed residences near proposed new stops
- Community group & stakeholder outreach
   Close partnership with UCSF
- Notices posted along new bus zones
- Public hearing on November 14



# LONG TERM PLAN FOR 16<sup>TH</sup> STREET

- 55 16<sup>th</sup> Street is the first step in 16<sup>th</sup> Street plan
- Implement transit only lanes
- Improved reliability & safety
- Extends 22 Fillmore to Mission Bay
- Outreach starts this month









## **TITLE VI ANALYSIS**

- Completed Title VI analysis as required by the SFMTA Board approved Major Service Change Policy and the Federal Transit Administration
- Residential population on new line:
  - 59% self identify as a minority compared to 58% citywide
  - 29% reported household incomes below 200% of the federal poverty level compared to 32% citywide
- No disparate impact to minority populations or disproportionate burden to low income populations
