Natural Surveying Variability (+/- 4%)*

*Natural surveying variability for an actual mode split of 50% driving, 50% active transportation and shared modes, for a survey of 750 participants, is +/- 4%

l've taken a few trips [in the last year]	9%	10%	7%	
I have not ridden a bike, but wanted to	23%	21%	26%	/
