- Federal Transit Administration signed the Federal Environmental Impact Study and Record of Decision
 - Published in the Federal Register on June 15
 - Available at GearyBRT.org
- Developing Conceptual Engineering Report based on Locally Preferred Alternative



9. Geary Boulevard Improvement Project Update



 Notice of Intent: During Design Phase, request utility companies to identify existing and/or abandoned facilities within the project limits



• Utility companies provide information to project
