Islais Creek Facility – Overview

- 8.4-acre bus maintenance yard on the north shore of Islais Creek.
- Accommodates 165, 40-foot and 60-foot hybrid buses and 19 non-revenue (maintenance) vehicles.
- Seven lines run out of the facility:
 - 1AX/BX California Express
 - 7X Noriega Express
 - 8 Bayshore
 - 8AX/BX Bayshore Express
 - 38 Geary

- Event theme "Get to Know Your Neighbor Potrero Yard".
- Content will cover why we need to modernize the yard, how the yard currently functions, and the future height and mass of the building.
- Information and activity-based tables will be setup at the event site and scheduled Potrero Yard tours will take place.








Passive Feedback Examples





What Do You Envision Here? Sample




