- Substantial Muni service reduction, but 38 Geary and 38R Geary Rapid continue to operate

- Work confirmed for Memorial Day weekend, 8:00 p.m.
 Friday May 22 through Monday, May 25, rain or shine
- Each of the three spans will disconnected from supports, lifted by cranes and loaded onto trailers to be delivered to disposal facilities



 Spiral and folded ramps will be demolished in-place using hydraulic concrete processors to break up structures; debris loaded into dump trucks for transport off-site

"Geary Blvd Water/Sewer" contract: Masonic to Van Ness

- "Segment A" work is complete (Masonic to Fillmore).
- "Segment B" is underway between Fillmore and Franklin.

"Geary East" contract: Van Ness to Market Street

• Water main work is underway between Polk and Jones streets. Some pedestrian bulbs on O'Farrell Street have been completed

"Geary East" contract: Van Ness to Market Street

 Decommissioned cable car tracks from old O'Farrell line (discontinued 1954) found at O'Farrell/ Shannon



10. Geary Rapid – Implementation update

"West Surface" contract: Stanyan to Van Ness

- Managed by Public Works, awarded to Esquivel Grading & Paving.
- Issued Notice to Proceed on February 19, 2020.
- Field work started last week between Masonic and Scott streets.





Construction Notice

Construction of Geary Rapid Project transit and safety improvements is being done by contractor Esquivel Grading and Paving. The Geary Rapid Project aims to make traveling on Geary a more reliable and safer experience, and is coordinated with other city-sponsored work to keep infrastructure in a state of good repair. This contract includes:

- Sidewalk extensions at bus stops and intersection corners, new crosswalks and other pedestrian safety improvements between Stanyan Street and Van Ness Avenue.
- Repaving between Masonic and Van Ness avenues.
- New and upgraded traffic signals.
