## SUBJECT: Sanitization Products

Beginning Friday, June 5, 2020, SFO will offer sanitizing products for use by taxi drivers in the SFO hold lots. Taxi drivers may use the products while they are in the lot. To use the products, ask the dispatcher in Lot 2. You will need to sign out the sprays and equipment, and the dispatcher will hold your Drivers License until you return the sprays and equipment.

You MUST dispose of any paper towels or other trash in trash can. Carefully read the provided instructions before using. Use of these products is at your own risk and the airport cannot assume any liability. This equipment is only for use on a San Francisco taxicab in active passenger service at SFO. If you are dispatched to the curb before you have returned the sanitizing supplies, you may either hand the equipment back in immediately and go, or if you have more to sanitize, you may pull off to the side, finish sanitizing, and be the next cab dispatched once you are done.
