FOR PROPOSED PARKING & TRAFFIC CHANGES

Pursuant to SFMTA Order No. 5823 adopted September 1, 2017, the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency will hold a public hearing to solicit public input on the following proposed changes. The hearing will be held as follows:

Date/Time: Friday, September 15, at 10:00 am
Location: Room 416 (Hearing Room 4), City Hall, San Francisco
(located on Van Ness Avenue between McAllister and Grove Streets)

1. **ESTABLISH – RED ZONE**

Clarendon Avenue, south side, from midblock crosswalk between Laguna Honda Boulevard and Olympia Way to 40 feet westerly

2. **RESCIND – BUS ZONE**

ESTABLISH – COMMERCIAL LOADING ZONE, 8 AM TO 7 PM, DAILY

ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY, NO PARKING, 7 PM TO 8 AM, DAILY

Stanyan Street, west side, from Haight Street to 40 feet southerly

3. **ESTABLISH – PART-TIME PASSENGER LOADING ZONE, TOW-AWAY, NO PARKING, 7AM-9AM, 2PM-4PM, SCHOOL DAYS**

Clipper Street, north side, from Noe Street to 125 feet westerly *

4(a). **RESCIND – SCHOOL BUS ZONE, 7AM TO 3PM, SCHOOL DAYS**

ESTABLISH – PART-TIME SCHOOL BUS LOADING ZONE, TOW-AWAY, NO PARKING, 7AM-9AM, 2PM-6PM, SCHOOL DAYS

Broadway, north side, from 163 feet to 245 feet west of Powell Street *

4(b). **RESCIND – PART-TIME PASSENGER LOADING ZONE, 7AM TO 3PM, SCHOOL DAYS**

ESTABLISH – PART-TIME PASSENGER LOADING ZONE, TOW-AWAY, NO PARKING, 7AM-9AM, 2PM-6PM, SCHOOL DAYS

Broadway, north side, from 143 feet to 163 feet west of Powell Street *

5. **ESTABLISH – TOW AWAY, NO STOPPING ANYTIME**

Otis Street, west side, from Duboce Avenue to 75 feet northerly (right-turn pocket replaces yellow metered space 152)

Items denoted with an asterisk () can be approved by the City Traffic Engineer after the public hearing and such approval constitutes the CEQA **Approval Action** under S.F. Administrative Code Section 31.04(h). Otherwise, the SFMTA Board will make the final approval at a later date based on the outcome at the public hearing.*

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Appeal Rights under Chapter 31 of the San Francisco Administrative Code: For **Approval Actions**, the Planning Department has issued a CEQA exemption determination or negative declaration, which may be viewed online at <http://www.sf-planning.org/index.aspx?page=3447>. Following approval of the item by the SFMTA City Traffic Engineer, the CEQA determination is subject to appeal within the time frame specified in S.F. Administrative Code Section 31.16, typically within 30 calendar days of the Approval Action. Under CEQA, in a later court challenge, a litigant may be limited to raising only those issues previously raised at a hearing on the project or in written correspondence delivered to the Board of Supervisors or other City board, commission or department at, or prior to, such hearing, or as part of the appeal hearing process on the CEQA decision

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- 6(a). **RESCIND – PERPENDICULAR PARKING**
ESTABLISH – PARALLEL PARKING
Indiana Street, west side, from 19th Street to 350 feet northerly
- 6(b). **ESTABLISH – NO PARKING ANYTIME**
ESTABLISH – SIDEWALK WIDENING
Indiana Street, west side, at 19th Street (sidewalk widening for 18.5-foot wide bulb, west leg of intersection to be permanently closed)
- 7(a). **RESCIND – PERPENDICULAR PARKING**
ESTABLISH – PARALLEL PARKING
Indiana Street, west side, from 20th Street to 665 feet southerly
- 7(b). **ESTABLISH – NO PARKING ANYTIME**
ESTABLISH – SIDEWALK WIDENING
- A. Indiana Street, west side, at 20th Street (sidewalk widening for 31-foot wide bulb, west leg of intersection to be permanently closed)
 - B. Indiana Street, west side, from 250 to 335 feet south of 20th Street (sidewalk widening for 31-foot wide bulb)
 - C. Indiana Street, west side, from 495 to 535 feet south of 20th Street (sidewalk widening for 27-foot wide bulb)

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- 8(a). **ESTABLISH – RAISED MEDIAN**
7th Street, from Mission Bay Drive to 30 feet north of Channel Street *
- 8(b). **ESTABLISH – NO LEFT TURN**
7th Street, northbound, at Channel Street
Channel Street, eastbound, at 7th Street
- 8(c). **ESTABLISH – SIDEWALK WIDENING**
ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY NO STOPPING ANYTIME
A. Hooper Street, north side, from 7th Street to 36 feet westerly (creates 6-foot wide bulb, removes 2 parking spaces)
B. Hooper Street, north side, from 74 feet to 157 feet west of 7th Street (creates 6-foot bulb, removes 4 parking spaces)
C. Hooper Street, north side, from 495 feet to 578 feet west of 7th Street (creates 6-foot wide bulb, removes 4 parking spaces)
D. Channel Street, south side, from 481 feet to 609 feet west of 7th Street (creates 5 foot wide bulb)
- 8(d). **ESTABLISH – RED CURB**
Hooper Street, south side, from 7th Street to 40 feet westerly
- 8(e). **ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY NO STOPPING ANYTIME**
Channel Street, north side, from Carolina Street to 7th Street

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- 9(a). **ESTABLISH - TOW-AWAY NO PARKING, PERMITTED COMMUTER SHUTTLE ZONE ONLY, 4 PM TO 10 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY**
Columbus Avenue, east side, from 77 to 192 feet north of Via Bufano (Restricts parking at four metered spaces #714, #716, #718, and #720 and one driveway)
- 9(b). **ESTABLISH - TOW-AWAY NO PARKING, PERMITTED COMMUTER SHUTTLE ZONE ONLY, 6 AM TO 10 AM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY**
Columbus Avenue, west side, from Scotland Street to 89 feet southerly (restricts parking at four metered spaces #723, #725, #729, and #731)
- 9(c). **ESTABLISH - TOW-AWAY NO PARKING, PERMITTED COMMUTER SHUTTLE ZONE ONLY, 6 AM TO 10 AM AND 4 PM TO 10 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY**
Broadway, north side, from 15 to 101 feet west of Front Street (restricts parking in four metered spaces, #104, #106, #108, #110)
Broadway, south side, from 10 to 94 feet east of Osgood Place (restricts parking in four metered spaces, #313, #315, #317, #319)
- 9(d). **RESCIND – ABILITY FOR PERMITTED COMMUTER SHUTTLES TO USE MUNI BUS ZONE**
Broadway, north side, from Grant Avenue to 100 feet westerly
Columbus Avenue, west side, from Broadway to 95 feet southerly

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
