1. Minutes: PSAC approved the December minutes.

2. Election of PSAC Officers for 2014: PSAC elected: Chair: Zack Marks; Vice-Chair: Chris Coghlan and Secretary: Howard Strassner.

3. Opening Comments: Zack: There were seven more traffic collision deaths in December to bring total for 2013 to 21, highest since 2007.

4. Sgt. Mahoney, SFPD Traffic Company: a) Investigating cases and submitting information to the District Attorney. b) Gross negligence is not defined. Ordinary negligence is a misdemeanor per the vehicles code.

5. Assistant Deputy Fire Chief Ken Lombardi: A) Stated need for rolled curbs at corners for EMS(Fire Engines & Ambulances) to roll over them without damaging the vehicle. B) He stated Valencia's redesign from 2 years ago now makes it easier with short response time for EMS to drive north or south on this road of two auto lanes & 1 bike lanes with wider sidewalks.

6. Paul Giusti from Recology reported this garbage retrieval company as a worker owned Co-op is responding through SF Bicycle Coalition to the bicyclist fatality in May 2013 and will meet with Walk SF because of the December 18th fatality of a pedestrian on Jones Street. He and Mahoney reported that the pedestrian was at fault. PSAC: Recology vehicles should have back-up cameras and exterior back up sound notification.
