The Mid-Valencia Curbside Protected Bikeway Project was approved by the SFMTA Board of Directors on November 19, 2024. Revisions to the approved project include the following elements:

- An additional green zone to provide more short term loading for local businesses
- Increase the number of blue zones to provide more accessible parking spaces on Valencia and area streets
- Revisions to the bikeway on 17th Street approaching Valencia Street
- Modify the number, configuration, and hours of parking and loading spaces to better accommodate the new roadway configuration and needs of merchants and business owners
- Reinstate left turns off of Valencia Street at three northbound and three southbound locations (17th St, 21st, and 23rd St) between 15th Street and 23rd Street
