GUERRERO STREET QUICK-BUILD PROJECT



The Guerrero Street Quick-Build Project adds new safety spot treatments at key intersections along Guerrero Street to better safety and comfort for all street users. New treatments include painted safety zones and turn calming to improve pedestrian visibility and safety, as well as to encourage drivers to make turns at safer speeds.

- Refreshed existing continental crosswalks with • new paint
- Improved pedestrian crossings and sightlines/ • visibility with advanced limit lines
- Turn calming treatments using delineators and rubber speed bumps
- Painted safety zones (PSZs) at locations where right-turn crashes or driver compliance were an issue
