WHEREAS, The SFMTA has proposed parking regulations and amendments to the Transportation Code, Division II, Section 801, to improve access for City Hall and to accommodate passenger and commercial loading needs for the new housing developments on Van Ness Avenue and Grove Street:

- A. RESCIND PERMIT PARKING ONLY, AT ALL TIMES
 ESTABLISH BLUE ZONE, ACCESSIBLE PARKING, AT ALL TIMES
 Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, west side, from 20 feet to 41 feet north of Grove Street (Permit Space #49, 21-foot zone)
- B. RESCIND PERMIT PARKING ONLY, 6 AM TO 7 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY
 ESTABLISH GREEN ZONE, SHORT-TERM PARKING, 15-MINUTE TIME LIMIT, 6 AM TO 7 PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY
 Grove Street, north side, from 120 feet to 130 feet west of Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place (Permit Space #75, 10-foot zone)
- C. RESCIND PERMIT PARKING ONLY, 6 AM TO 7 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY ESTABLISH – BLUE ZONE, ACCESSIBLE PARKING, AT ALL TIMES Grove Street, south side, from 25 feet to 48 feet west of Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place (Permit Space #14, 23-foot zone)
- D. ESTABLISH YELLOW METERED ZONE, SIX-WHEEL COMMERCIAL LOADING, 30-MINUTE TIME LIMIT, AT ALL TIMES Grove Street, north side, from 37 feet to 107 feet east of Van Ness Avenue (70-foot zone)
- E. RESCIND BLUE ZONE, ACCESSIBLE PARKING, AT ALL TIMES Van Ness Avenue, east side, from 17 feet to 36 feet north of Dr. Tom Waddell Place (19-foot zone)
- F. ESTABLISH WHITE ZONE, ACCESSIBLE PASSENGER LOADING, 5-MINUTE TIME LIMIT, AT ALL TIMES

 Van Ness Avenue, east side, from 10 feet to 67 feet north of Dr. Tom Waddell Place (57-foot zone)
- G. RESCIND YELLOW METERED ZONE, COMMERCIAL LOADING, 7 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY Grove Street, south side, from 92 feet to 114 feet east of Van Ness Avenue (22-foot zone)
- H. ESTABLISH YELLOW METERED ZONE, SIX-WHEEL COMMERCIAL LOADING, 30-MINUTE TIME LIMIT, 8 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY
 - Grove Street, south side, from 92 feet to 117 feet east of Van Ness Avenue (25-foot zone)
- I. RESCIND PERMIT PARKING ONLY, 6 AM TO 7 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY

 ESTABLISH WHITE ZONE ACCESSIBLE BASSENGER LOADING 5 MINUT
 - ESTABLISH WHITE ZONE, ACCESSIBLE PASSENGER LOADING, 5-MINUTE TIME LIMIT, AT ALL TIMES

Grove street, south side, from 117 feet to 177 feet east of Van Ness Avenue (Permit Spaces #93, #92, & #91, 60-foot zone); and,

WHEREAS, Staff engaged both City Hall and the developer to finalize the proposed changes; and,

WHEREAS, The public has been notified about the proposed modifications and has been given the opportunity to comment on those modifications through the public hearing process; and,

WHEREAS, The proposed parking modifications are subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). CEQA provides a categorical exemption from environmental review for operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities pursuant to Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations Section 15301; and

WHEREAS, On May 2, 2025, the SFMTA, under authority delegated by the Planning Department, determined that the proposed parking modifications (Case No. 2025-003182ENV) are categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations Section 15301; and,

WHEREAS, The proposed action is the Approval Action as defined by the San Francisco Administrative Code Chapter 31; and

WHEREAS, A copy of the CEQA determination is on file with the Secretary to the SFMTA Board of Directors, and may be found in the records of the Planning Department by Case Number at https://sfplanninggis.org/pim/ or 49 South Van Ness Avenue, Suite 1400 in San Francisco, and are incorporated herein by reference, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors approves parking modifications, as set forth in Items A through I above; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors amends Transportation Code, Division II regarding permit parking near City Hall and establishing commercial loading, passenger loading, short term parking, and blue zone parking on Grove Street, Van Ness Avenue, and Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place.

Resolution amending Division II of the Transportation Code to revise restrictions on Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, Ellis Street, and Grove Street.

The Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors of the City and County of San Francisco enacts the following regulations:

Section 1. Article 800 of Division II of the Transportation Code is hereby amended by revising Section 801, to read as follows:

SEC. 801. PARKING RESTRICTIONS BY LOCATION.

- (a) It shall be a violation of Division I, Section 7.2.42 (Parking Restrictions) for any person to Park any vehicle, whether attended or unattended, in any of the locations listed below during times when Parking is restricted without displaying a valid permit for Parking in that location. A permit issued for Parking pursuant to this Article does not exempt a vehicle from street-cleaning Parking restrictions. These parking restrictions shall not apply to any state, federal, or foreign consulate vehicle parked to carry out official government business.
- (b) **Removal Authorized.** Pursuant to the authority of Vehicle Code Section 22651(n) any vehicle Parked in violation of this Section 801 may be removed by the SFMTA or SFPD.

(14) Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place.

(A) Locations:

- (i) Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, east side, from 49 feet to 206 feet north of Grove Street (157-foot zone, accommodating 8 parallel parking stalls);
- (ii) Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, east side, from 54 feet to 195 feet south of McAllister Street (141-foot zone, accommodating 7 parallel parking stalls);
- (iii) Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, west side, from 49 feet to 231 feet south of McAllister Street (182-foot zone, accommodating 9 parallel parking stalls);
- (iv) Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, west side, <u>from 41 feet to 147</u> <u>feed north of Grove Street (106-foot zone, accommodating 5 parallel parking stalls). from 28 feet to 155 feet north of Grove Street (127 foot zone, accommodating 6 parallel parking stalls).</u>
- (B) **Time:** For subsection (14)(A)(i) and (14)(A)(ii), from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Friday. For subsections (14)(A)(iii) and (14)(A)(iv), at all times.
- (C) **Exempt Vehicles:** Vehicles displaying a permit issued by the SFMTA.

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(16) Ellis Street.

(A) Location:

(i) The south side of Ellis Street, south side, from 144 feet to 194 feet west of Taylor Street (50-foot zone, 1 parking meter space).

(ii) Ellis Street, south side, from 12 feet to 30 feet west of Powell Street (18-foot zone).

- (B) **Time:** For subsection (16)(A)(i), from 1:30 p.m. to 10:30 p.m., Monday to Friday. For subsection (16)(A)(ii), from 8:30 a.m. to 8:30 p.m., daily.
- (C) **Exempt Vehicles:** <u>For subsection (16)(A)(i),</u> (Pit Stop Program) SF Public Works vehicles. <u>For subsection (16)(A)(ii), SFMTA vehicles.</u>

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(21) Grove Street.

(A) Locations:

- (i) Grove Street, north side, <u>from 30 feet to 90 feet west of Dr.</u>

 <u>Carlton B. Goodlett Place (60-foot zone, accommodating 6 angled parking stalls).</u> between Van Ness

 <u>Avenue and Polk Street (360 foot zone, accommodating 25 angled parking stalls).</u>
- (ii) Grove Street, north side, from 130 feet to 220 feet west of Dr.

 Carlton B. Goodlett Place (90-foot zone, accommodating 9 angled parking stalls).

(iii) (iii) Grove Street, south side, from 48 feet to 206 feet west of Dr.

Carlton B. Goodlett Place (158-foot zone, accommodating 7 parallel parking stalls). from 25 feet to

206 feet west of Polk Street (181-foot zone, accommodating 8 parallel parking stalls).

- (B) **Time:** 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.
- (C) **Exempt Vehicles:** Vehicles displaying a permit issued by the SFMTA.

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Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective 31 days after enactment. Enactment occurs when the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors approves this resolution.

Section 3. Scope of Resolution. In enacting this resolution, the San Francisco

Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors intends to amend only those words,

phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles, numbers, letters, punctuation marks,

charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Transportation Code that are explicitly

shown in this resolution as additions or deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears

under the official title of the resolution.
