Guerrero Street Quick-Build Project

The SFMTA implemented quick-build spot safety improvements to key intersections of the Guerrero Street corridor from Market Street to 20th Street last summer. Work included refreshing painted continental crosswalks, enhancing pedestrian visibility with advance limit lines, and installing painted safety zones & turn calming treatments in locations with frequent interactions between people walking and driving.

Since the improvements went in, vehicle speeds dropped by 12 percent, from 25 mph pre-construction to 22 mph post-construction. Average left-turn speeds at intersections also dropped to 10 mph, which aligns with national guideline recommendations. Meanwhile, average weekday traffic volumes remained stable and driver yielding to pedestrians improved, with about 80 percent of drivers yielding at treatment intersections.

Next Up for Approvals



Larkin Street Quick-Build Project

Following the August 1st public hearing, the Larkin Street Quick-Build Project is now headed toward the next and final step in the approval process at the SFMTA Board of Directors next month. The project proposes targeted pedestrian safety improvements between Market and Sutter Streets in response to a high rate of traffic collisions—150 over five years, with 41% involving pedestrians.

Upgrades include turn safety enhancements, a lane reduction from Geary Street to Sutter Street, the addition of three new left turn lanes at key intersections, installation of general loading zones, and installation of additional blue zones. These improvements are designed to improve safety, reduce conflicts, and enhance traffic flow and curb access. Construction is expected to begin in October, coordinated with San Francisco Public Works' paving schedule.

School Daylighting

SFMTA's Daylighting Program is a citywide effort to improve visibility and safety at intersections by removing parking at the first 20 feet of a crosswalk. This simple, but effective change known as daylighting helps drivers better see people crossing the street, reducing the risk of crashes. In a commitment to implementing red curbs citywide as part of the statewide Daylighting law, AB 413, SFMTA prioritized locations adjacent to schools while ongoing citywide daylighting work continues. From March through July, SFMTA completed daylighting at over 2,000 nonmetered school locations.
