7. Presentation, discussion and possible action regarding Passenger Service Reports. (Travis Fox, Chief Information Officer)

8. Presentation, discussion and possible action regarding Cable Car performance. (Ed Cobean, Senior Operations Manager, Cable Car Division)

Ed Cobean discussed monitoring of cable car service; cable car headways and turnarounds at cable car terminals; bus substitution and signage when a cable car line is down; and improvements to cable car service.

Chairman Ballew suggested that Mr. Cobean return in six months to provide an update on cable car service improvements.

9. Presentation, discussion and possible action regarding the placement of ADA ramps. (Annette Williams, Manager, Accessible Services)

Annette Williams discussed the design and installation of an ADA ramp at 5<sup>th</sup> and Irving Street and future ADA ramp installations.
