**SUBJECT:** TaxiQ App Update for Lot Closure Notifications

Later this week, SFO will be releasing an update to the TaxiQ app that will provide notifications to drivers when the taxi lot is full. This information is intended to help drivers avoid congestion at SFO when the lot entrance is closed. Drivers who enable the feature will receive a notification when taxi lot staff closes the lot and another notification when it reopens.

If you have configured your phone to install app updates automatically, the TaxiQ app will update itself when the new version is released. (The release date is determined by the Google and Apple app stores, but it is expected to be on or after December 7.) If you have not configured your phone to update apps automatically, you will be prompted to update the app manually approximately one week after the release.

To take advantage of the new features, please select the option to allow TaxiQ to send push notifications after updating the app. To change your preferences at a later time, access your phone settings to enable or disable notifications for the TaxiQ app.
