WHEREAS, Since February 1, 1994, the Department of Transportation has required recipients of federal assistance to have a drug and alcohol testing and employee training program in place for employees performing safety-sensitive functions; and,

WHEREAS, On July 10, 2013 a Request for Proposal was issued to request proposals from a qualified urine collector and breath alcohol technician to perform either mobile on-site and/or off-site collection services for the SFMTA's drug and alcohol program; and,

WHEREAS, In response to the Request for Proposal, City Services was the only respondent to conduct on-site mobile collection services; and,

WHEREAS, The Director of Transportation recommends that a contract be awarded to City Services to provide professional services; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors authorizes the Director of Transportation to execute an agreement with City Services, 2425 Church lane #20, San Pablo, California, 98406 to provide mobile on-site urine and breath collection services for an amount not to exceed \$850,000 and a term not to exceed five years with an option of two-one year extensions at the sole discretion of the Director of Transportation.
