Union Street Festival continued

The following street closures will be required from 12:01 a.m., Saturday, to midnight, Sunday:

- Union Street between Gough and Fillmore streets
- Octavia Street between Green and Filbert streets
- Laguna Street between Green and Filbert streets
- Buchanan Street between Green and Filbert streets
- Webster Street between Green and Filbert streets
- Intersections: Union Street at Octavia, Laguna, Buchanan and Webster streets

Fillmore Street will remain open for through traffic, it may be congested due to crowds. Local access for residents will be allowed on the impacted streets except for Union Street.

The following Muni routes will be affected: **45 Union/Stockton**.

<u>Statuto Race</u>

Sunday, June 2: The 99th annual Italian Club Statuto Race will begin at 9 a.m. in North Beach. This race consists of an eight-mile run and a two-mile walk starting from Washington Square Park to North Point to Herb Caen Way along the waterfront to Bryant Street and return to Washington Square. UPDATE: Central Subway Project

In Chinatown, the sidewalk on the west side of Stockton Street, south of Washington Street, adjacent to the worksite is temporarily closed to facilitate utility upgrade work. There is currently one lane of traffic open on both sides of Stockton between Clay and Jackson streets. UPDATE: UCSF Mission Bay Arena Platform Project

To facilitate additional work in association with the construction of the new platform, an additional T Third bus substitution has been in place since Saturday, May 25 and continuing for about ten days. For more information visit <u>www.SFMTA.com/MissionBayPlatform</u>.

Buses are providing T Third service between The Embarcadero and Sunnydale since Saturday, May 25 and will continue for about ten days in order to accommodate the next phase of construction.

During construction, the E Embarcadero has been temporarily canceled. Alternative routes include F Market & Wharves.

In anticipation of the new Golden State Warriors' arena, the SFMTA is constructing a new 320foot center platform along 3rd Street between South and 16th streets. The existing platform has been demolished. The new track alignment will include one single and one double crossover to facilitate the movement of vehicles as operations requires. Other associated work includes modification of the overhead contact system, and both above and below ground utility relocation work. UPDATE: Van Ness Improvement Project

On Friday, May 31, between the hours of 8 p.m. and 7 a.m., crews are scheduled to work on street light conduits at the following locations:

UPDATE: Van Ness Improvement Project continued

Because some work requires reducing Van Ness Avenue to one lane in each direction, some work is limited to nighttime hours. UPDATE: Geary Rapid Project

The first phase of construction as part of the <u>Geary Rapid Project</u> continues. Work to replace aging water and sewer lines between Masonic and Van Ness avenues is being done in coordination with San Francisco Public Utilities Commission.

The following weekend construction forecast is subject to change due to weather delays or unexpected field conditions.

Weekend street closures between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m.:

- Planned street closure of northbound and southbound traffic on Scott Street between Post and O'Farrell streets on **Saturday**, **June 1 and Sunday**, **June 2** while crews work on water main replacement.
- Only local vehicle access will be allowed, including drop-offs. Parking will be temporarily restricted in the area.
- No bus stops will be affected, and eastbound and westbound traffic on Geary Boulevard will be maintained.

ONGOING: Construction of Mission Bay Loop

The SFMTA has resumed construction on 18th, 19th and Illinois streets, the project is expected to be completed in summer 2019. Traffic, including travelling by bike, may be affected by the construction work. All work areas will be clearly marked and there will be flaggers to help direct traffic. In order to conduct the work, parking on both sides including along the historical Crane Cove Park fence (east side of Illinois Street) will be removed 24 hours, 7 days a week from 18th to 19th and Illinois streets for the duration of the project.

ONGOING: Construction of Mission Bay Loop continued

A partial street closure is currently in effect in order to accommodate duct bank work on Illinois Street between 18th and 19th streets through summer of 2019. Outer traffic lanes traveling both north and south on Illinois Street will remain open for through traffic. Immediately following the duct bank work, the track work will begin.

Upcoming Construction Project

Twin Peaks Tunnel Temporary Closures

There are planned temporary closures scheduled for the Twin Peaks Tunnel **in the mornings of Saturday, June 8 and Sunday, June 9, from start of service to 10 a.m.**, to allow crews to do track maintenance work. This brief closure includes the West Portal and Forest Hill stations. During that time, bus shuttles will be provided for the K, L and M lines. Trains will continue to serve all stations between Castro and Embarcadero.

<u>K Ingleside</u>

- **Inbound:** Trains will serve regular stops from Balboa Park to St. Francis Circle, where customers must transfer to shuttle buses. Buses will serve shuttle bus stops from St. Francis Circle to Embarcadero Station.
- **Outbound:** Bus shuttles will run from Castro to St. Francis Circle.

<u>L Taraval</u>

- **Inbound:** No train service. L inbound buses will serve all stops from the Zoo (46th/Wawona) to Embarcadero Station.
- **Outbound:** No train service. L outbound buses will run from Castro to the Zoo (46th/Wawona).

<u>M Ocean View</u>

- **Inbound:** Trains will serve regular stops from Balboa Park to St. Francis Circle, where customers must transfer to shuttle buses. Buses will serve shuttle bus stops from St. Francis Circle to Embarcadero Station.
- **Outbound:** Bus shuttles will run from Castro to St. Francis Circle.
