

PUBLIC HEARING

FOR PROPOSED PARKING & TRAFFIC CHANGES

Pursuant to SFMTA Order No. 5363 adopted December 24, 2014, the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency will hold a public hearing to solicit public input on the following proposed changes. The hearing will be held as follows:

ESTABLISH – STOP SIGN

Anza Street at 2nd Avenue, making this intersection an all-way STOP

ESTABLISH – NO RIGHT TURN ON RED

Sacramento Street, westbound, at Stockton Street
Stockton Street, southbound, at Sacramento Street

ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY NO STOPPING ANYTIME

4th Street, west side, from Mission Street to 60 feet northerly (rescinds two 15-minute green metered parking spaces, #58 and #60 for a right-turn lane)
4th Street, east side, from 34 feet to 118 feet south of Minna Street (rescinds an 84-foot long passenger loading zone due to sidewalk widening)
