Introduction

The Guerrero/Dolores Median Parking Policy Advisory Committee (The Advisory Committee) will review and make recommendations regarding on-street, weekend median parking policies along Guerrero and Dolores streets to the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) for consideration. This issue affects access and mobility for everyone living in or visiting the neighborhood, including: residents, businesses, park visitors, and houses of worship. The entire process will be open to the public, and City staff will be available as resources.
