The Sustainable Streets Division of the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency will hold a public hearing on Friday, August 17, 2012, at 10:00 AM, in Room 416 (Hearing Room 4), City Hall, 1 Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, San Francisco, CA 94102, to consider the following proposals:

ESTABLISH – RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA BB, 1-HOUR PARKING, 8 AM TO 7 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY

RESCIND – RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA BB, 2-HOUR PARKING, 8 AM TO 8 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY

Turk Boulevard, 2300-2800 blocks, south side, between Parker Avenue and Masonic Avenue

Golden Gate Avenue, 2200-2500 blocks, north side, between Parker Avenue and Masonic Avenue

Masonic Avenue, 300 block, west side, from Turk Boulevard to Golden Gate Avenue

Annapolis Terrance, unit block, both sides, between Turk Boulevard and Golden Gate Avenue

Tamalpais Terrance, unit block, both sides, between Turk Boulevard and Golden Gate Avenue

Roselyn Terrance, unit block, both sides, between Turk Boulevard and Golden Gate Avenue

Kittredge Terrance, unit block, both sides, between Turk Boulevard and Golden Gate Avenue

Chabot Terrance, unit block, both sides between Turk Boulevard and Golden Gate Avenue

Temescal Terrance, unit block, both sides, between Turk Boulevard and Golden Gate Avenue

Parker Avenue, 500 Block, east side, between Turk Boulevard and Golden Gate Avenue

RESCIND – UNMETERED MOTORCYCLE PARKING

Palm Avenue, west side, between 129 and 133 Palm Avenue

ESTABLISH – NO PARKING ANYTIME

Winston Drive, north side, from Broadmoor Drive to 25 feet easterly

Winston Drive, south side, from Broadmoor Drive to 25 feet westerly

ESTABLISH – RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA "F", 2-HOUR PARKING, 9 AM TO 4 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY

Laurel Street, 500 block, west side, between Euclid and Mayfair Streets

Collins Street, unit block, both sides, between Euclid and Mayfair Streets

Euclid Street, 200 Block, both sides, between Collins and Laurel Streets

Mayfair Street, unit block, south side, between Laurel and Collins Streets

ESTABLISH – 2-HOUR PARKING TIME LIMIT, 7 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY

Harrison Street, south side, between 13th Street and 11th Street

13th Street, north side, between 11th Street and Harrison Street (excluding the small traffic island at 11th Street)

ESTABLISH – RED ZONE

13th Street, north side, at the 11th Street northwest corner traffic island (2 parking spaces)

ESTABLISH – RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA I & Z (BUFFER ZONE), 1-HOUR PARKING 9 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY

Valencia Street, 1400 block, both sides, between 25th and 26th Streets ELIGIBILITY ONLY

(No new signs to be installed)

25th Street, 3500 block, both sides, between Valencia Street and San Jose Avenue

26th Street, 3500 block, north side, between Valencia Street and San Jose Avenue

ESTABLISH – STOP SIGN

Stopping Burrows Street at San Bruno Avenue, making this intersection a two-way stop

ESTABLISH – NO PARKING ANYTIME EXCEPT BICYCLES

Post Street, north side, at 754 Post Street for a distance of 7'– 8" west of the Parklet (between Jones and Leavenworth Streets)

RESCIND – NO LEFT TURN, 7 AM TO 9 AM, 4 PM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY

ESTABLISH – NO LEFT TURN (AT ALL TIMES)

Northbound Powell Street at Sutter Street

ESTABLISH – NO PARKING ANYTIME

9th Street, west side, from Folsom Street to 25 feet southerly (sidewalk widening for 6-foot wide bulb, southwest corner)

9th Street, west side, from Folsom Street to 25 feet northerly (sidewalk widening for 6-foot wide bulb, northwest corner, removing yellow zone meter #262)

9th Street, east side, from Folsom Street to 25 feet southerly (sidewalk widening for 6-foot wide bulb, southeast corner)

ESTABLISH – YELLOW METERED LOADING ZONE (7 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY)

9th Street, west side, from 48 feet to 69 feet north of Folsom Street (replacing general meter 258 with a yellow meter)

The purpose of traffic engineering hearings for the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) Sustainable Streets Division is for residents to express their concerns regarding the posted parking and traffic changes affecting their streets. At the hearing, the public hearing officer, after reviewing the items and listening to residents, will make a decision as to whether the items are approved or not. Any interested parties are encouraged to attend.
