WHEREAS, In Resolution No. 12-091 the SFMTA Board of Directors established a reserve fund to cover potential claims (the Litigation Reserve); now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors authorizes the Director of Transportation, in consultation with the Chief Financial Officer and City Attorney's Office, to use funds from the Litigation Reserve to pay the settlement; and be it further

RESOLVED, That on recommendation of the Director of Transportation and the City Attorney, the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors approves the settlements listed below:

- A. Ericka Hurd, et al. v. City and County of San Francisco, et al., Superior Ct. Case No. CGC-23-611235 filed 12/21/2023 for \$90,000. Lawsuit involving allegations of personal injury from operator negligence (Plaintiffs' vehicle and revenue vehicle).
- B. CSAA Insurance Exchange and Reynaldo Hilario, Unlitigated Claim No. C26-0010 for \$30,911.14 (SFMTA to receive). Claim involving allegations of property damage to City property.
