Van Ness Corridor Transit Improvement Project



Project Scope

- San Francisco's first Bus Rapid Transit (BRT)
- Overhead Contact System (OCS) replacement
- SFGo Traffic signal system replacement and upgrade
- Sewer replacement
- Water and Auxiliary Water Supply System
 replacement
- Streetlight replacement including additional sidewalk lighting
- New landscaping and rain gardens
- Street repaving

Pre-construction Outreach

- Collected pre-construction impact surveys from 85% of project-facing properties
- Low-vision and blind wayfinding report
- Tree Selection Open House
- Presentations to merchant, neighbor and community groups
- Project-specific Community Advisory Committee
- Monthly project update emails
- Project hotline and email

Muni Subway System Upgrade Projects

- Blue Light Emergency Telephone Replacement replace 90 old Blue Light emergency telephones with 181 new units to improve emergency communications for Muni customers and first responders
- Radio Communications Upgrade replace the old analog system and upgrade it to digital technology
- Twin Peaks Tunnel Trackway Improvement replace light rail tracks along the entirety of Twin Peaks Tunnel

Construction Outreach

- Held three open houses
- Provided updates at neighborhood association meetings
- The SFMTA Ambassadors canvassed the subway stations informing Muni customers of the subway construction and helping them find the bus stops.
- Collaborated with the Giants in reaching out to the baseball fans

Unity Plaza Development Project

- 10 years of community planning & meetings for the Balboa Park Station Area Plan.
- 2015: A meeting with affordable housing residents. There was no opposition.
- Meeting scheduled for August with merchants and residents.
