PROJECT LOCATION AND SUMMARY

- 50,000 daily Muni riders
- Vision Zero High Injury Network Corridor
- 36 pedestrian and vehicle collisions in past seven years
- Low Income Muni Routes (73%)
- Minority Muni Routes (82%)
- Senior Muni Routes (20% over 55 on 9)





PROJECT GOALS

- Improve safety for all users of the corridor
- Increase the reliability of Muni
- Optimize parking supply near the commercial core
- Improve bike safety and connections



COMMUNITY OUTREACH

- English and Cantonese Kickoffs 2015
- 4 Open Houses fall 2015-spring 2016
- Pop-up Meeting at Bacon Bus
 Stop Oct 2015
- Door to Door Outreach to merchants and residents







COMMUNITY OUTREACH – WHAT WE HEARD

- Buses are crowded and not always reliable
- Difficult to park

 Concerns about parking loss
- Narrow sidewalks get crowded at busy bus stops
- Double parking slows the bus
- Updated proposal to add or modify project elements



PROPOSAL SUMMARY

Transit Improvements

- 5 Transit Bulb-Outs
- 1 Traffic Signal
- Morning tow-away zones to address congestion approaching Alemany and Silliman
- Bus Zone changes to improve safety and efficiency

Safety Improvements

- Intersection Daylighting
- 2 Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons
- 7 Pedestrian Bulb-Outs
- Bike lanes between Paul and Mansell

Parking management modifications based on merchant and resident feedback

EXPECTED OUTCOMES OF IMPROVEMENTS

- Reduced Muni travel time on this corridor by 15%
- Improved Muni reliability
- Increased safety at bus stops
- Enhanced safety for pedestrians at key intersections
- Increased parking turnover to enhance corridor vibrancy



NEXT STEPS & PROJECT TIMELINE

- Design: Fall 2016 through Spring 2017
- Construction: begin middle to end of 2017

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PROPOSAL REVISIONS

- Keep inbound Wayland bus stop
- New pedestrian bulbs at Woolsey, Wayland, and Burrows
- Modified transit bulb design southwest corner of Bacon St
- New parking meters in Woolsey and Wayland pocket streets, and from Wayland and Woolsey on San Bruno Ave
- Revised meter time limits in various locations
- Tow-away zone in AM peak to alleviate congestion
- Sidewalk extension near Silver Ave on the eastside
- Bike lanes on San Bruno Ave (Paul Ave to Mansell Ave)
- Keep outbound Wilde stop for connection with 56 Rutland
