## **RESOLUTION No. 13-002**

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency has received a request, or identified a need for traffic modifications as follows:

- A. RESCIND TOW-AWAY NO STOPPING ANYTIME California Street, north side, from 27 feet to 40 feet east of Pierce Street.
- B. ESTABLISH NO RIGHT TURN ON RED, EXCEPT BICYCLES Westbound McCoppin Street at Valencia Street; and Westbound 29<sup>th</sup> Street at San Jose Avenue.
- C. ESTABLISH TOW-AWAY, NO PARKING, 10 PM TO 6 AM, DAILY 25<sup>th</sup> Street, both sides, between Pennsylvania and 3<sup>rd</sup> streets.
- D. ESTABLISH STOP SIGNS Stopping Division Street at Bryant Street, southernmost intersection, eastbound, stopping the stem of this T-intersection; and Stopping Alameda Street at Bryant Street, westbound, stopping the stem of this T-intersection.
- E. ESTABLISH RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA J, 2-HOUR PARKING, 7 AM TO 7 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY – Belvedere Street, 600 Block, both sides, between Carmel and 17<sup>th</sup> Streets.
- F. ESTABLISH RED ZONES Berry Street, south side, from King Street to 23 feet westerly; and Berry Street, south side, from easternmost crosswalk at King Street to 23 feet westerly.
- G. ESTABLISH TOW-AWAY, NO PARKING ANYTIME, EXCEPT NOON 2 PM, WEDNESDAY Carolina Street, west side of median, between 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> streets.
- H. ESTABLISH TOW-AWAY, NO PARKING ANYTIME, EXCEPT NOON 2 PM, MONDAY Carolina Street, east side of median, between 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> streets.
- I. ESTABLISH BLUE ZONE 3299 Ortega Street, south side, from 0 feet to 20 feet east of  $40^{th}$  Avenue.
- J. ESTABLISH BLUE ZONE 1998 41<sup>st</sup> Avenue, east side, from 7 feet to 25 feet north of Pacheco Street crosswalk.
- K. ESTABLISH NO PARKING, 9 AM TO 7:30 PM, DAILY Montgomery Street, east side, from Union Street to 8 feet northerly.
- L. ESTABLISH PARKING METER AREA 3 (NO TIME LIMIT 9 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY) – Turk Street, 900 block, both sides from Gough Street to 450 feet westerly.

WHEREAS, The public has been notified about the proposed modifications and has been given the opportunity to comment on those modifications through the public hearing process; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors, upon recommendation of the Director of Transportation and the Director of the Sustainable Streets Division does hereby approve the changes.
