Golden Gateway Garage Ventilation (Complete)

- \$2.7 million in 2014 Revenue Bonds.
- Substantially complete in October 2016.
- Mechanical and electrical upgrades and replacement of the ventilation system (air handling units, exhaust fans, supply air, ducts, louvers), carbon monoxide monitoring systems and controls, and associated electrical support.



Sutter Stockton Garage Ventilation (Complete)

- \$1.7 million project in 2014 Revenue Bonds.
- Substantially complete in October 2016.
- Mechanical and electrical upgrades and replacement of the ventilation system (air handling units, exhaust fans, supply air, ducts, louvers), carbon monoxide monitoring systems and controls, and associated electrical support.



Japan Center Garage Ventilation (Complete)

- \$2.4 million project in 2014 Revenue Bonds.
- Substantially complete in June 2017.
- Mechanical and electrical upgrades and replacement of the ventilation system (air handling units, exhaust fans, supply air, ducts, louvers), carbon monoxide monitoring systems and controls, and associated electrical support.





Lombard Garage Waterproofing (Complete)

- \$5.0 million project in 2014 Revenue Bonds.
- Substantially complete in January 2019.
- Replaced the facade of the Lombard Parking Garage, repaired the concrete spall at the top deck and 2nd floor and applied waterproofing.



Other Projects

- Parking Garage Projects Condition Assessment, Waterproofing & Ventilation
 - \$5.0 million in 2012B Revenue Bonds
 - \$1.0 million in 2013 Revenue Bonds
 - \$0.1 million in 2014 Revenue Bonds
- Elevator Modernization Multiple Garages
 - \$0.4 million in 2014 Revenue Bonds
- Ellis O'Farrell Seismic Upgrade
 - \$0.2 million in 2014 Revenue Bonds

PARCS replacement project for 21 garage facilities (Ongoing)

- \$7.4 million in 2014 Revenue Bonds.
- Complete replacement of the Parking Access and Revenue Control System (PARCS) components at 21 parking facilities. This includes new system servicers, cashier stations, ticket spitters, barrier gates, payment machines, etc. and the installation of new utility infrastructure required to support the new equipment.
- Substantially complete at 13 of 21 garage facilities.
