This project will address safety concerns while creating a more comfortable space for travel through the following changes on Howard Street between the Embarcadero and 3<sup>rd</sup> Street:

- Upgrading the existing bike lane on the north side of Howard Street (westbound direction) between 3<sup>rd</sup> Street to the Embarcadero to a parking protected bikeway to provide a safer and more comfortable place for people traveling by bike.
- The bikeway upgrade requires reprioritization of the roadway space to accommodate the new bike facility. This would include the reduction of: 1 vehicle traffic lane in the westbound direction between 3<sup>rd</sup> and Fremont streets, 1 vehicle traffic lane in the eastbound direction between Fremont and Beale Streets, and 1 vehicle traffic lane in the westbound direction between Beale Street and the Embarcadero.
- Installation of pedestrian safety improvements such as intersection daylighting and installing or modifying the location of advanced limit lines (stop bar) throughout the project area.
- Installation of 3 transit boarding islands.
- Installation of the new parking protected bikeway, transit boarding islands, and intersection daylighting requires the removal of some on-street parking throughout various segments in the project area. Overall, the project would result in the removal of 33 general metered parking spaces, an addition of 4 new commercial loading zones, and the removal of 4 passenger loading zones on Howard Street between 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and the Embarcadero.

Pending project approvals, implementation could begin as early as Spring 2020.

- F. Bryant Street, south side, from 7<sup>th</sup> Street to 25 feet westerly

#### 2(v). ESTABLISH – PASSENGER LOADING ZONE, 7 AM TO 4 PM, SUNDAY

7<sup>th</sup> Street, east side, from 75 feet to 215 feet south of Cleveland Street



#### 2(w). ESTABLISH – YELLOW LOADING ZONE, 7 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY

7<sup>th</sup> Street, east side, from 25 feet to 60 feet south of Cleveland Street



# These items (Howard Street Quick-Build Project and 7<sup>th</sup> Street Quick-Build Safety Project) can be given approval by the City Traffic Engineer after the public hearing.

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Appeal Rights under Chapter 31 of the San Francisco Administrative Code: For Approval Actions, the Planning Department has issued a CEQA exemption determination or negative declaration, which may be viewed online at http://www.sf-planning.org/index.aspx?page=3447. Following approval of the item by the SFMTA City Traffic Engineer, the CEQA determination is subject to appeal within the time frame specified in S.F. Administrative Code Section 31.16, typically within 30 calendar days of the Approval Action. For information on filing a CEQA appeal, contact the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors at City Hall, 1 Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, Room 244, San Francisco, CA 94102, or call (415) 554-5184. Under CEQA, in a later court challenge, a litigant may be limited to raising only those issues previously raised at a hearing on the project or in written correspondence delivered to the Board of Supervisors or other City board, commission or department at, or prior to, such hearing, or as part of the appeal hearing process on the CEQA decision.

Whether the City Traffic Engineer's decision is considered a Final SFMTA Decision is determined by Division II, Section 203 of the Transportation Code. If the City Traffic Engineer approves a parking or traffic modification, this decision is considered a Final SFMTA Decision. If a City Traffic Engineer disapproves a parking or traffic modification and a member of the public requests SFMTA review of that decision, the additional review shall be conducted pursuant to Division II, Section 203 of the Transportation Code. City Traffic Engineer decisions will be posted on <a href="https://www.sfmta.com/committees/engineering-public-hearings">https://www.sfmta.com/committees/engineering-public-hearings</a> by 5 p.m. on the Friday following the public hearing. Final SFMTA Decisions involving certain parking or traffic modifications, whether made by the City Traffic Engineer or the SFMTA Board, can be reviewed by the Board of Supervisors pursuant to Ordinance 127-18.
