- Safety issues are proactively identified and mitigated not only reactively addressed
- Safety information is communicated throughout the agency

- Federal Transit Administration will conduct oversight through the Triennial Review process
- Public Transportation Agency Safety Plan requirements will be added to Federal Transit Administration's comprehensive review guide
