ESTABLISH - BUS ZONE

Geary Boulevard, north side, from 100 feet to 120 feet east of 30th Avenue (extends existing bus zone by an additional 20 feet)

<u>ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY NO STOPPING ANY TIME, PART-TIME BUS ZONE, 6 AM TO 10 AM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY</u>

Geary Boulevard, north side, from 120 feet to 240 feet east of 30th Avenue

ESTABLISH – STOP SIGN

Minerva Street, westbound, at Plymouth Avenue, stopping the stem of this "T" intersection

<u>ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY NO STOPPING, BUSES & TAXIS ONLY LANE, 3 PM TO 7 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY</u>

Sacramento Street, westbound, from Kearny Street to Larkin Street (extends part-time Muni only lane, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, 4 PM TO 6 PM)

<u>ESTABLISH – 2-HOUR PARKING, 8 AM TO 3 PM AND 7 PM TO 10 PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY, EXCEPT VEHICLES WITH AREA C PERMITS</u>

Sacramento Street, north side, between Stockton Street and Hyde Street (900 block through 1400 block; adjusts RPP hours for consistency with extended Tow-away No Stopping hours)

<u>ESTABLISH – 2-HOUR PARKING, 8 AM TO 3 PM AND 7 PM TO 10 PM, MONDAY</u> <u>THROUGH SATURDAY, EXCEPT VEHICLES WITH AREA C AND AREA G PERMITS</u>

Sacramento Street, north side, between Hyde Street and Larkin Street (1500 block; adjusts RPP hours for consistency with extended Tow-away No Stopping hours)

ESTABLISH - RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA U, 2-HOUR PARKING, 8 AM TO 10 PM, DAILY, EXCEPT VEHICLES WITH AREA U PERMIT

McLea Court, north side, between 9th Street and its terminus (all addresses on both sides of the street will be eligible to purchase permits)

ESTABLISH - RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING ELIGIBILITY, AREA I

3365 -3369 17th Street (eligibility only; no signage required)

ESTABLISH - STOP SIGNS

15th Street, eastbound and westbound, at Beaver Street, making this an all-way STOP Beaver Street, northbound, at 15th Street, making this an all-way STOP

ESTABLISH - NO PARKING VEHICLES OVER 6 FEET HIGH

15th Street, north side, from Beaver Street to 100 feet easterly

ESTABLISH - STOP SIGNS

Linda Street, northbound and southbound, at 19th Street

ESTABLISH - NO PARKING VEHICLES OVER 6 FEET HIGH

Keith Street, west side, from Wallace Avenue to 100 feet northerly

ESTABLISH - STOP SIGNS

Lower Great Highway, northbound and southbound, at Kirkham Street, making this intersection an all-way STOP

ESTABLISH – RED ZONE

Plymouth Avenue, west side, from Montaga Street to 20 feet southerly (20-foot red zone).*

ESTABLISH - STOP SIGN

Hill Street, eastbound, at Church Street, stopping the stem of this "T" intersection

ESTABLISH - STOP SIGNS

Harriet Street, northbound and southbound, at Harrison Street, making this intersection a two-way STOP

ESTABLISH – RED ZONE

19th Street, north side, from Lamson Lane to 25 feet easterly 19th Street, north side, from Lamson Lane to 12 feet westerly *

Santa Ynez Avenue, north side, from Capistrano Avenue to 20 feet westerly (extends existing hydrant red zone to 30 feet) *

Santa Ynez Avenue, north side, from Capistrano Avenue to 58 feet easterly (clarifies existing unmarked crosswalk)

ESTABLISH – BUS BULB

Hayes Street, north side, from Laguna Street to 55 feet easterly (8.2-foot sidewalk widening for existing bus zone; adds back one parking space)

ESTABLISH - NO STOPPING ANYTIME

Ivy Street, north side, from Laguna Street to 105 feet easterly (for 6-foot sidewalk widening on south side; removes approximately 5 parking spaces)

ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY NO PARKING ANYTIME ESTABLISH – SIDEWALK WIDENING

- A. Pacheco Street, south side, from 9th Avenue to 25 feet easterly (for 6-foot wide sidewalk widening)
- B. Pacheco Street, north side, from 9th Avenue to 25 feet easterly (for 6-foot wide sidewalk widening)
- C. 9th Avenue, east side, from Pacheco Street to 25 feet northerly (for 6 foot wide sidewalk widening)
