ESTABLISH - SPEED CUSHIONS

Clayton Street, between Ashbury Street and Parnassus Street (2 Speed Cushions) *

ESTABLISH - SPEED CUSHIONS

Ashbury Street, between Clayton Street and Piedmont Street (2 Speed Cushions) * Ashbury Street, between Piedmont Street and Frederick Street (2 Speed Cushions) *

RESCIND – SCHOOL BUS LOADING ZONE, 7:30 AM TO 4:30 PM, SCHOOL DAYS ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY, NO STOPPING ANYTIME, PASSENGER LOADING ZONE, 7:30 AM TO 9:30 AM AND 2:30 PM TO 4:30 PM, SCHOOL DAYS

14th Avenue, east side, from Santiago Street 102 feet northerly *

ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY, NO STOPPING ANYTIME, SCHOOL BUS LOADING ZONE, 7:30 AM TO 4:30 PM, SCHOOL DAYS

14th Avenue, east side, from Santiago Street 103 feet southerly *

ESTABLISH – RADAR SPEED FEEDBACK SIGNS

Ulloa Street, eastbound and westbound, between Forest Side Avenue and Wawona Street *

ESTABLISH – STOP SIGNS

Noriega Street, eastbound and westbound, at 20th Avenue, making this intersection an all-way STOP

ESTABLISH – STOP SIGN

16th Avenue, southbound at Wawona Street, stopping the stem of the "T" intersection

ESTABLISH – STOP SIGN

15th Avenue, northbound, at Lawton Street, stopping the stem of this "T" intersection

ESTABLISH - NO COMMERCIAL VEHICLES WITH MORE THAN 9 SEATS

Lombard Street, between Mason Street and Taylor Street

Items denoted with an asterisk (*) can be approved by the City Traffic Engineer after the public hearing and such approval constitutes the CEQA **Approval Action** under S.F. Administrative Code Section 31.04(h). Otherwise, the SFMTA Board will make the final approval at a later date based on the outcome at the public hearing.

Following approval of the item by the SFMTA City Traffic Engineer, the CEQA determination is subject to appeal within the time frame specified in S.F. Administrative Code Section 31.16, typically within 30 calendar days of the Approval Action. Colon Avenue, northbound, at Brentwood Avenue, stopping the stem of the "T" intersection

ESTABLISH - NO PARKING ANYTIME

Highland Avenue, north side, from 190 feet to 202 feet east of Arlington Street (12-foot extension of existing restriction)

ESTABLISH - NO PARKING ANYTIME

Lower Terrace, north side, from 169 feet to 177 feet east of Roosevelt Way (8-foot extension of existing restriction) *

ESTABLISH - STOP SIGN

Alton Avenue, eastbound, at Castenada Avenue, stopping the "T" stem of this intersection

ESTABLISH – STOP SIGN

Brussels Street, southbound, at Campbell Avenue, stopping the "T" stem of this intersection

ESTABLISH - RED ZONE

Garfield Street, north side, from Byxbee Street to 22.5 feet westerly

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ESTABLISH - SPEED HUMPS

Collins Street, between Euclid Avenue and Geary Boulevard (2 Speed Humps)*

ESTABLISH – SPEED HUMPS

Commonwealth Avenue, between California Street and Euclid Avenue (2 Speed Humps)*

Jordan Avenue, between California Street and Euclid Avenue (2 Speed Humps)*

Masonic Avenue, west side, from 167 feet to 367-feet south of Euclid Avenue

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ESTABLISH – RED ZONE

California Street, south side, from 14th Avenue to 25 feet westerly (25-foot zone)

ESTABLISH – NO PARKING ANYTIME

ESTABLISH – CURB EXTENSION

Seacliff Avenue, south side, from 25th Avenue to 25 feet westerly 25th Avenue, west side, from Seacliff Avenue to 35 feet southerly Seacliff Avenue, south side, from 26th Avenue to 66 feet easterly

ESTABLISH - RED ZONE

Ocean Avenue, north side, from Paloma Avenue to San Benito Way (40-foot zone)

ESTABLISH – RAISED CROSSWALK

Division Street, north crosswalk, at 9th Street* Division Street, south crosswalk, at 9th Street *

ESTABLISH – TRAFFIC SIGNAL

Bryant Street at Sterling Street

ESTABLISH – TRAFFIC ISLAND

Bryant Street at Sterling Street (interim treatment before traffic signal) *

ESTABLISH – NO PARKING ANYTIME

Bryant Street, north side, from Sterling Street to 8 feet easterly * Bryant Street, south side, from 20 feet to 60 feet east of west Sterling Street property line (40foot zone, removes two metered spaces #353 and #357)

Sacramento Street, north side, from Webster Street to 19 feet westerly (sidewalk widening for 5-foot wide bulb)

<u>RESCIND – YELLOW METERED LOADING ZONE, 9 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH</u> <u>SATURDAY</u>

Sacramento Street, north side, from 136 feet to 176 feet west of Webster Street (removes 2 spaces #2416 and 2418) *

<u>ESTABLISH – RED ZONE</u> ESTABLISH – SIDEWALK WIDENING

Webster Street, west side, from 2 feet to 20 feet north of Sacramento Street (removes parking meter space #2101) *

ESTABLISH – METERED MOTORCYCLE PARKING

22nd Street, north side, from 93 feet to 103 feet east of Valencia Street (2 motorcycle spaces next to newly constructed active driveway) *

ESTABLISH – UNMETERED MOTORCYCLE PARKING

7th Street, west side, from 10.5 feet to 53 feet north of King Street (11 Unmetered Motorcycle Stalls at 3.5 feet wide) *

ESTABLISH – STOP SIGN

Linden Street, eastbound, at Gough Street

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
