Public feedback areas

- Cross-street angled parking parking within marked stalls
- 29th Avenue perpendicular parking and Presidio Middle School student drop-off/pick-up
- Color curb changes hours and designations
- Desire for new shelters and real-time information ASAP
- 25th Avenue inbound stop
- Left-turn restrictions



Business support update

- Merchant mixer held on October 19
- Marketing Campaign survey for Geary project area merchants completed in October
- Advertised via postering, flyering, door-to-door from 15th-28th Avenue
- 158 businesses visited, 43 surveys completed

Business support update

- First meeting of nine-member Geary Small Business Working Group meeting held on November 29
- Group decided to prioritize marketing funds for decorative lighting and a Muni bus ad campaign



Community enhancement planning process

- Working with SF Public Works Landscape Architecture staff to define potential feasible concepts
- Two rounds of outreach in 2024:
 - 1. Feedback on concepts and design elements: Spring 2024
 - 2. Feedback on design details: Summer 2024

Stanyan to Market Street

- Only remaining work is restoration of three remaining segments of red thermoplastic transit lane colorization. Waiting for shop capacity due to other high priority work.
- The contractor is continuing to maintain the new trees as part of the threeyear plant establishment period.
- SFPW admin team is working on final contract payments and closeout.
