The SFMTA bus facility will support electric trolley buses and have infrastructure to transition to a future battery-electric bus fleet, as needed. This project would allow Muni to continue as a national leader in delivering sustainable transit service and puts it on the cutting edge of a 100 percent zero-emissions future.



Transit-Dense Community

The Project is conveniently located to public transit and bike networks within a 5-minute walk, reducing the need for personal automobile use and associated carbon emissions.



Green Corridor

A natural extension of Franklin Square Park, enhanced landscaping will be provided at the street level and throughout the Project.



Water Reuse
