

Alemany Boulevard (Ellsworth to Justin Drive/Congdon) Quick-Build Project

The Alemany Boulevard (Ellsworth to Justin Drive/Congdon) Quick-Build Project is currently wrapping up construction, aiming to enhance pedestrian, cyclist, and driver safety along this corridor. The project includes a road diet, a protected bikeway, and a new bus boarding island. The goals of the project are to reduce vehicle speeds on the High Injury Network and improve accessibility. Work planned for June includes building the bus boarding island and installing concrete barriers along portions of the bikeway. Additional refinements will continue as the project moves toward full completion, ensuring safety improvements for the community.

Valencia Bikeway Improvements

The Valencia Bikeway Improvements project is now open to cyclists, just in time for National Bike Month. After an outreach-intensive process that prioritized both community input and safety, the final design now features side-running protected bike lanes that better align with the corridor's needs. This layout separates cyclists from vehicle traffic, while also preserving space for parklets, passenger loading, and goods delivery. The project was shaped by extensive feedback from residents, merchants, and other stakeholders, reflecting a balance between accessibility, safety, and economic vitality.

The project team celebrated the completion of the project with a ribbon cutting ceremony during the inaugural Valencia LIVE!, a neighborhood celebration on Valencia Street from 16th Street to 19th Street on the second Thursday of every month from 5 to 10 PM, May through October this year.

7th Street Bike Signal Upgrade

A new bike signal for northbound 7th Street at Mission Street is now active! This significant milestone was celebrated this month leading up to Bike to Wherever Day. A ribbon cutting event highlighted this key follow up improvement to protected bikeways installed along 7th Street in previous years. This improvement reflects the spirit of the Quick-Build Program, where early installations are continually monitored and enhanced through design iterations. With this new signal, people biking now experience clear traffic signal phase separation from right-turning drivers, creating a safer and more predictable intersection for all.

Evaluation Results



Williams Avenue Quick-Build Project

The SFMTA evaluated the Williams Avenue Quick-Build Project and found several changes in how the street is being used. Typical weekday vehicle speeds fell by 17%, from 31 mph to 26 mph, closer to the posted speed limit of 25 mph. Drivers yielding to pedestrians increased by 38%. Double parking has decreased significantly, from 31 incidents to just 3. While there are fewer cars overall and average loading times have increased slightly, more people are walking and biking.
