- Manual citywide PM peak period bicycle counts gathered since 2006
- Reports also show American Community Survey data
- Today 75 Automated Bicycle Counters throughout S.F.
- Interactive bike count data now displayed on SFMTA.com/bikecount

SFMTA's new site that displays the dashboards with automated bike counter data

According to the American Community Survey, bike mode share for commute trips made by San Francisco residents was 4.3% in 2015.



The 2016 manual bike counts, at 19 locations counted during the PM peak in September, indicated a 10% increase from the 2015 manual bike counts, and a

213% 🌻 (more than threefold) increase from the

2006 bike counts.

In 2016, May had the highest monthly bike counts with approximately

bikes logged at the 44 locations monitored by automated bike counters.

Morning bike commute volumes are relatively concentrated, peaking around 8 a.m., but evening bike commute volumes are more spread out from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m.

A 5% decrease

in bike counts was reported from 24 automated bike counters from November and December of 2015 to November and December of 2016. Wet weather conditions in 2016 was a factor in this decrease.

> There are an estimated 82,000 🕿 bike trips in San Francisco per day.
