# Fourth of July Muni Service, Parking Will Be Enforced

**Thursday, the Fourth of July holiday,** Muni will operate on a <u>Sunday schedule</u>. The 76X Marin Headlands Express Muni bus will be in service.

Parking meters and seven-day street sweeping will be enforced citywide on the holiday. Residential parking permits and Monday-Friday daytime street sweeping and commuter towaway will not be enforced.

Vehicles creating a hazard and/or an unsafe condition (i.e. double parking, blocking a bike lane, blocking driveways, blocking crosswalks, fire hydrants, etc.) are subject to receiving citations and can possibly be towed.

## **Annual July 4 Independence Day Fireworks Celebration**

**Thursday, July 4**: The July 4 annual Independence Day Fireworks Celebration will start at 2 p.m. along the waterfront near the Municipal Pier and Pier 39. Entertainment will be at Pier 39, Aquatic Park and Ghirardelli Square. The fireworks display will begin at 9:30 p.m. **Muni will operate on a <u>Sunday schedule</u>**, **but <u>extra Muni service</u> will be provided to and from the fireworks display on The Embarcadero.** The 76X Marin Headlands Express Muni bus will be in service.

Starting from around noon to 11 p.m., large crowds and heavy traffic should be expected to and from Treasure Island.

At approximately 8:30 p.m., no traffic will be allowed north of Lombard Street, from Van Ness to Doyle Drive, except for residents.

As many as 200,000 people are expected in the event area. Traffic congestion and disruption of transit service are expected in the northern section of the city. To ensure safety of the riding public, customers should pay attention to their surroundings and allow extra travel time to get around the City.

  - o Marina Boulevard exit off Doyle Drive may be closed
- 6 a.m., Wednesday to 5 p.m., Thursday
  - o Jefferson Street from Aquatic Park to Hyde Street
- 6 a.m., Thursday to 4 a.m., Friday
  - o The Embarcadero between Powell and Mason streets
- 8 a.m. to 11:30 p.m., Thursday
  - o Van Ness Avenue between North Point Street and the Municipal Pier Terminus
  - o Beach Street from Polk Street to the Terminus
- 11 a.m., Thursday to 4 a.m., Friday
  - o Jefferson Street between Hyde and Powell streets
- 9:20 to 10:15 p.m., Thursday
  - o Northbound Embarcadero between Broadway and Bay Street

**Note**: As the crowd grows and to ensure safety of pedestrians, SFPD Police Officers and SFMTA Parking Control Officers can decide to close Fisherman's Wharf area bounded by The Embarcadero, Van Ness Avenue and Bay Street earlier than the scheduled time listed above to vehicular traffic.

#### **Pre-Event Service**

Starting at 2 p.m. until 8:30 p.m., Muni will provide extra service to connect people from Muni Metro Subway, BART, Ferries and Caltrain to both viewing area along The Embarcadero, **from Caltrain Station to the Pier 39**.

#### Post-Event Service

Return express shuttle service will begin after the fireworks display at around 9 p.m. until 11:30 p.m. Shuttles will board at two locations:

- Kearny and North Point streets for service to the Ferry Building and Caltrain station
- Van Ness and Bay streets for service to Civic Center Muni/BART Station

Once the crowds disperse, regular Muni service will resume. This can take at least a half hour. Participants and those traveling in the area are asked to allow extra travel time.

## Purchasing Muni Fare [Note: New Muni Fare effective July 1]

Between 2:30 and 8:30 p.m., SFMTA staff will be selling transfers at the Ferry Building, inbound F Market & Wharves platform. Muni customers are encouraged to purchase their round-trip fare in advance or use a Clipper® Card. Regular Muni fares apply:

- \$3 for adults (age 19-64) or \$6 for a round trip fare
- \$1.50 for seniors (ages 65 and older), youth (5-18) or \$3 for a round trip fare
- \$1.50 for people with disabilities or \$3 for a round trip fare
- All single ride fares paid for by cash or Clipper Card will receive the regular 2-hour transfer

#### Muni Reroutes

The following regular Muni lines and routes will be re-routed due to congestion in the event area: E Embarcadero\*; F Market & Wharves\*\*; 8 Bayshore Express; 19 Polk; 28 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue; 30 Stockton; 39 Coit; 47 Van Ness and 49 Van Ness-Mission.

- \* The E Embarcadero line will only operate as streetcars until 2 p.m. After 2 p.m. bus shuttles will operate along The Embarcadero to 4th and King/Townsend Streets on Thursday, July 4.
- \*\* The F Market & Wharves line will operate on regular Muni buses all day on Thursday, July 4.

The Powell-Hyde, Powell-Mason and California cable car lines will operate on regular Muni buses after 2 p.m.

# Fillmore Street Jazz Festival

**Saturday, July 6 and Sunday, July 7**: The 36<sup>th</sup> Annual Fillmore Street Jazz Festival will be held from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. each day on Fillmore Street between Jackson and Eddy streets. The following street closures will be required from 12:01 a.m., Saturday to 11:59 p.m., Sunday:

- Fillmore Street between Jackson and Eddy streets
- Washington and Clay streets between Webster and Steiner streets
- O'Farrell Street between Fillmore and Steiner streets
- Intersections: Ellis, Wilmot, O'Farrell, Washington and Clay streets at Fillmore Street

The closure of O'Farrell Street is also designated for the <u>Fillmore Farmers' Market</u> which will take place from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Saturday.

Monitored bicycle parking will be available on Fillmore Street at Jackson Street.

#### **UPDATE: Muni Track Work at Judah Street & 17th Avenue**

**Starting Monday, July 8,** for about four weeks, N Judah track maintenance work will take place at Judah Street and 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue. During construction, the N Judah rail service is operating without interruption. While Judah Street remains open, vehicular traffic along 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue is temporarily for "right turn only" until work completed.

Work hours are from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Saturday. During construction:

- While measures are being taken to minimize inconvenience, neighbors can expect some noise during demolition.
- To accommodate the construction, four parking spaces, two on each side of Judah Street east of the intersection, will be used as staging areas. They are unavailable for parking 24 hours a day for the duration. Additionally two or three parking spaces on the remaining sides of the street are unavailable during construction hours.
- Crosswalks and sidewalks may be occasionally closed.
- Due to lane closures, slow traffic is expected. All travelers, especially drivers, are encouraged to leave extra time and move carefully through the area.

## <u>UPDATE: Muni Track Work at Judah Street & 17th Avenue continued</u>

There is no construction work scheduled for this weekend.

Because some work requires Van Ness Avenue has been reduced to one lane in each direction, some work is limited to nighttime hours. Construction scheduling is subject to change due to weather delays or unexpected field conditions. For more project details and the latest construction updates, visit sfmta.com/vanness.

#### **UPDATE: Third Street Bridge Rehabilitation Project**

Third Street Bridge rehabilitation project **started on Monday, June 24**. Crews began working a second shift at night after general work hours. Construction work is taking place between the hours of 8 p.m. and 7 a.m. Night work is anticipated to continue nightly, Monday through Saturday, **through 7 a.m., Friday October 4**.

Crews will soon transition into phase two of rehabilitation activity starting Sunday, July 7. Transition into phase two involves travel lane shifts and other adjustments to the roadway and work area. Vehicle and bicycle access via travel lanes across the bridge continue to be available in each direction, northbound and southbound (except during periods of full temporary bridge closures when the pending scope of work restricts access across the bridge for all vehicle, bicycle and pedestrian traffic). Pedestrian access are available via the sidewalk along the eastern side of the bridge. Bicycles may also choose to walk their bicycle along the pedestrian sidewalk as an alternative to riding across the bridge via the travel lane. Pedestrian access via the sidewalk along the western side of the bridge may be unavailable during different phases of upcoming work.

#### Road Closures

**Monday, July 8 to Wednesday, July 17:** To facilitate ongoing rehabilitation activity, a temporary full closure of the bridge will be implemented. All vehicle, bicycle and pedestrian traffic will be restricted. Full temporary bridge closures are only anticipated to be in effect between the following dates:

# <u>UPDATE: Third Street Bridge Rehabilitation Project continued</u>

Construction scheduling is subject to change due to rain or other weather delays, equipment breakdown, and/or unforeseen field conditions. Additional periods of short closures may be possible in September and October 2019, if necessary, to complete remaining rehabilitation work. Information will be shared closer to that period should additional closures seem necessary and details are finalized. Updates will be posted to the project webpage.

## **ONGOING: UCSF Mission Bay Arena Platform Project**

In anticipation of the new Golden State Warriors' arena, the SFMTA is constructing a new 320foot center platform along 3<sup>rd</sup> Street between South and 16<sup>th</sup> streets. The existing platform has been demolished. The new track alignment will include one single and one double crossover to facilitate the movement of vehicles as operations requires. Other associated work includes modification of the overhead contact system, and both above and below ground utility relocation work. Construction will require different phases of work that will necessitate separate transit service plans. For the latest information. visit www.SFMTA.com/MissionBavPlatform.

## **ONGOING: Construction of Mission Bay Loop**

The SFMTA has resumed construction on 18<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup> and Illinois streets, the project is expected to be completed in summer 2019. Traffic, including travelling by bike, may be affected by the construction work. All work areas will be clearly marked and there will be flaggers to help direct traffic. In order to conduct the work, parking on both sides including along the historical Crane Cove Park fence (east side of Illinois Street) will be removed 24 hours, 7 days a week from 18<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> and Illinois streets for the duration of the project.

A partial street closure is currently in effect in order to accommodate duct bank work on Illinois Street between 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> streets through summer of 2019. Outer traffic lanes traveling both north and south on Illinois Street will remain open for through traffic. Immediately following the duct bank work, the track work will begin.

## **ONGOING: Central Subway Project**

In Chinatown, the sidewalk on the west side of Stockton Street, south of Washington Street, adjacent to the worksite is temporarily closed to facilitate utility upgrade work. There is currently one lane of traffic open on both sides of Stockton between Clay and Jackson streets. ## **L Taraval Improvement Project**

The L Taraval Improvement Project will start construction in July 2019 to realize permanent and comprehensive safety components, along with repair and rehabilitation of aging sewer and water lines, worn rails, overhead wires, and roadways. The project will be in two phases/segments:

- Phase One of the project will focus on the streets from SF Zoo to Sunset Blvd (Segment A)

- The duration of the project is approximately 3 years
