PTASP Safety Culture

- Safety is everyone's responsibility - from the top of the organization including the Board and Director of Transportation - to the frontline employees
- Employees are empowered to play a role in safety and report safety concerns to senior management
- Safety issues are proactively identified and mitigated – not only reactively addressed
- Safety information is communicated throughout the agency

- Federal Transit Administration will conduct oversight through the Triennial Review process
- Public Transportation Agency Safety Plan requirements will be added to Federal Transit Administration's comprehensive review guide
- California Public Utilities Commission will conduct state oversight of rail
