The Sustainable Streets Division of the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency will hold a public hearing on Friday, January 24, 2014 at 10:00 AM, in Room 416 (Hearing Room 4), City Hall, 1 Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, San Francisco, CA 94102, to consider the following proposals:

#### ESTABLISH - SHUTTLE BUS ZONE, 7AM TO 7PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY

410 Townsend Street, north side, from 0 feet to 35 feet east of the west property line (35-foot zone)

## ESTABLISH - GREEN ZONE, 9AM TO 6PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY

660 Powell Street, east side, from 12 feet to 56 feet south of Pine Street (44-foot zone)

## ESTABLISH - PASSENGER LOADING ZONE, 7AM TO 10PM, DAILY

300 Ivy Street, north side, from 69 feet to 91 feet west of Gough Street, west of bulb out (22-foot zone)

## ESTABLISH - BLUE ZONE

"801" Moscow Street, east side, from 0 feet to 18 feet north of the south crosswalk (18-foot zone)

2263 Union Street, south side, from 142 feet to 162 feet east of Steiner Street, at meter 2229 (20-foot zone) (to become general metered parking)

835 Pacific Avenue, south side, from 0 feet to 59 feet east of Trenton Street, at parking meters 815, 817 and 819 (59-foot zone)

3000 20<sup>th</sup> Street, north side, from 0 feet to 28 feet west of Florida Street (28-foot zone)

## **REVOKE – PASSENGER LOADING ZONE, DURING BUSINESS HOURS**

625 Polk Street, west side, from 43 feet to 82 feet north of Turk Street (39-foot zone)

# ESTABLISH – SHUTTLE BUS ZONE, 7AM TO 11PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, AND 10AM TO 11PM, SATURDAY AND SUNDAY

625 Polk Street, west side, from 3 feet to 62 feet north of Turk Street (59-foot zone)

# ESTABLISH – PASSENGER LOADING ZONE, DURING BUSINESS HOURS

625 Polk Street, west side, from 62 feet to 82 feet north of Turk Street (20-foot zone)

# **REVOKE – METERED LOADING ZONE, 7AM TO 6PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY**

1445 Bush Street, south side, from 176 feet to 194 feet east of Van Ness Avenue, at parking meter 1421 (18-foot zone)

## ESTABLISH – PART-TIME PASSENGER LOADING ZONE, 8AM TO 6PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY

1445 Bush Street, south side, from 0 feet to 33 feet east of meter stall 1425, at new meter stall 1421 (33-foot zone)

Public hearings are held once a month at City Hall to legislate the installation of new colored zones. The zones usually recommended for this process are blue, green, white, and yellow. The purpose of the hearing is for residents to express their concerns regarding proposed changes affecting their streets. All interested parties are encouraged to attend. At the Public Hearing, the Hearing Officer will review the items and listen to residents, then make a final decision. Upon approval and payment of any applicable installation fees, zones will be installed as soon as scheduling permits.
