## Pedestrian Safety Advisory Committee Draft Minutes September 9, 2014

Meeting Started at 6:00pm

- 1. Minutes: PSAC approved the August minutes.
- 2. Public Comment: Janice Li gave an update of the SF Bicycle Coalitions progress.
- 3. **Daylighting Resolution**: Becky Hogue presented. The legislative sub-committee did not recommended a vote on the legislation as written. Beck Hogue also reported that the PUC CAC resolution be sent back to the author for clarity.
- 4. **Public Comment**: Evelyn, Folks for Polk, Daylighting is mandatory in Seattle and the resolution should not be delayed due to the language in the draft.
- 5. Vision Zero Resolution: Tabled until the October 14<sup>th</sup> agenda. Chris Coghlan opposed.
- 6. **Public Comment**: Evelyn, Folks for Polk, what benefits cyclists and pedestrians benefits everyone. Evelyn urges the committee move forward with the Vision Zero resolution.
- 7. **Bob Beck / Treasure Island Development Program**: Bob Beck presented on the Treasure Island Development Program (Presentation attached). Chris Coghlan wanted clarity on the plan to charge a toll Bob Beck explained it will ease congestion on the Bay Bridge.
- 8. **Supervisor Scott Wiener / Prop B**: Supervisor Wiener presented on the legislation that will appear on the November ballot. Bond money cannot be used for "rolling stock" such as LRVs and busses, only capital improvement projects. Road resurfacing is covered by a previous bond. Chris Coghlan would like to see crosswalks marked where they currently don't exist.
- 9. **Ben Jose / SFMTA**: Ben Jose reporting on behalf of the SFMTA in Neil Patel's absence. School crossing guard program was 170 staffed as of the first day of school. Oak & Fell bulbout construction is set to be completed in September.
