FOR PUBLIC HEARING

The Sustainable Streets Division of the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency will hold a public hearing on Friday, July 19, 2013, at 10:00 AM, in Room 416 (Hearing Room 4), City Hall, 1 Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, San Francisco, CA 94102, to consider the following proposals:

1(a). <u>RESCIND – PERPENDICULAR PARKING</u>

Florida Street, west side, 644 feet north of 16th Street to 41 feet northerly

1(b). ESTABLISH – PARALLEL PARKING

Florida Street, west side, 644 feet north of 16th Street to 41 feet northerly

2. ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY NO STOPPING ANYTIME

Plymouth Avenue, west side, from Farallones Street to 25 feet northerly Plymouth Avenue, east side, from Farallones Street to 25 feet southerly

3. ESTABLISH – RED ZONE

Castro Street, east side, from Hill Street to 13 feet northerly* Castro Street, east side, from Hill Street to 14 feet southerly*

4(a). <u>ESTABLISH – 15-MILES PER HOUR SCHOOL SPEED LIMIT WHEN CHILDREN</u> <u>PRESENT</u>

Balboa Street, between 33rd Avenue and 36th Avenue

4(b). <u>ESTABLISH – PART-TIME PASSENGER LOADING ZONE, 8 AM TO 9:30 AM AND</u> <u>2 PM TO 5:30 PM, SCHOOL DAYS</u>

705 34th Avenue, west side, from Balboa Street to 54 feet southerly (54-foot zone)*

5. <u>REVOKE – PART-TIME PASSENGER LOADING ZONE, 8 AM TO 9 AM AND 3:30 PM</u> <u>TO 5:30 PM, SCHOOL DAYS</u>

1250 Quintara Street, north side, from 11 feet to 110 feet east of 22nd Avenue (99-foot zone)*

6. <u>ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY NO STOPPING ANYTIME</u> Bush Street, north side, from Kearny Street to 164 feet easterly

- 7. <u>ESTABLISH NO LEFT TURN</u> Alemany Boulevard at Theresa Street, Northbound
- 8. <u>ESTABLISH TOW AWAY, 3 PM TO 7 PM, EXCEPT BUSES</u> Main Street, west side, between Howard and Mission streets



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9(a). <u>RESCIND – RED ZONE</u>

Burnett Avenue, west side, from 46 feet to 86 feet south of Burnett Avenue

9(b). ESTABLISH – RED ZONE

Burnett Avenue, west side, from Burnett Avenue to six feet southerly* Parkridge Drive, west side, from Burnett Avenue to 54 feet northerly

The following items were environmentally cleared by the San Francisco Planning Department on December 7, 2008, Case number 2008.1315E.

10(a). ESTABLISH – PEDESTRIAN ISLAND

10(b). ESTABLISH – NO PARKING ANYTIME

11. ESTABLISH - ROAD DIET AND LANE REMOVAL

Balboa Street, between Funston and 24th Avenue Remove one westbound through lane

The following items were environmentally cleared by the San Francisco Planning Department on May 18, 2012, for information gathering purposes for a pilot project, case number 2011.0620E.

12(a). REVOKE – TOW AWAY, NO STOPPING ANYTIME

Market Street, south side, from 30 feet to 110 feet east of 10th Street*

12(b). ESTABLISH – NO PARKING EXCEPT BICYCLES

Market Street, south side, from 30 feet to 110 feet east of 10th Street (70-foot, 2 inch bike share station)*

Items denoted with an asterisk (*) can be given final approval at the public hearing. Otherwise, the SFMTA Board will make the final approval at a later date based on the outcome at the public hearing.

The purpose of traffic engineering hearings for the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) Sustainable Streets Division is for residents to express their concerns regarding the posted parking and traffic changes affecting their streets. At the hearing, the public hearing officer, after reviewing the items and listening to residents, will make a decision as to whether the items are approved or not. Any interested parties are encouraged to attend.
