# **Streamlining Process for Setting Fees and Fines**

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## **Types of Fees and Fines**

- Fines Assessed for violations adopted by state or local law
  - Parking
  - Transit
  - Taxi and mobility service
- Fees Assessed to recover costs associated with providing services
  - Environmental review
  - Towing
  - Parking permits
  - Relocation of signs, meter, etc.

### **Current process for fee and fine changes**

- There are more than 375 types of fees and fines contained within the Transportation Code
- Historically, the majority of fees are escalated by the SFMTAs Indexing policy – based on a combination of COLA (cost of living adjustment) and CPI (consumer price index)
- Two-year rates are adopted as part of the budget
- Most increases are administrative and routine
- Process is time consuming and cumbersome, requiring the preparation of a Transportation Code amendment exceeding 30 pages

- Transportation Code will be amended to:
  - Adopt current fees and fines as of March 19<sup>th</sup> as the base
  - Authorize escalation through an administrative process based on SFMTA indexing policy each year
  - Authorize charges for actual costs for special services requested such as sign and meter relocation, transportation studies, etc.

### **Budget review**

- As part of the two-year budget process, staff will review all fees and fines to identify those that require increases above indexing
- Basis for recommendations may include:
  - Changes to programs that have resulted in increased labor resources to administer
  - Furtherance of policy goals
  - Legislative changes
- Any rates proposed to be escalated above indexing will be included for approval by the Board of Directors as part of the budget process and subject to public hearing

#### **Budget review**

• Transit fares will continue to be approved by MTAB and sent to Mayor and Board of Supervisors as part of SFMTA budget.
